Juniperus tibetica Kom., showing trunk and stringy bark, growing in Tag-so valley where it forms pure stands at 10600 feet elevation. The tree is probably 500 years old.



70 (p. 189)

The Bâ valley at an elavation of 9940 feet, facing the northern slopes of the valley. The shrubs on the river-bank are *Lonicera syringantha*, back of them, *Salix Wilhelmsiana* M. v. B., *Salix juparica* Goerz, *Hippophae rhamnoides* L.; the tussocks on the hillside above are *Caragana tibetica* Kom.
