## OTHER PROGRAMS



### AVIATION DISPATCH

Dispatchers ensure that flights and aircraft maintenance run to schedule. They are involved in scheduling and flight planning, factoring flight times, weather, aircraft capabilities, airspace restrictions, and traffic. This fast-paced program may be completed in just five weeks.



### AVIATION BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

CAU business programs prepare students with a variety of general business and aviation industry essentials, including accounting, finance, management, marketing, and human resources. The programs are offered at the associate's degree, bachelor's degree and MBA levels.



### AVIATION MAINTENANCE

Students in the Associate of Science in Aviation Maintenance Technology degree program learn to test, inspect, and repair aircraft engines, as well as work with the aircraft systems and components. Graduates can work with a variety of aviation-related companies.

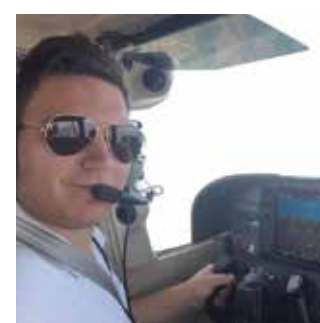
