Where some would have been protective of a program that had been in existence for years, Susan was a vocal advocate for change. The continued improvement of our religious high school program and the retention of students after Bar or Bat Mitzvah remains one of my top priorities. I join the rest of the congregation in wishing Susan all the best.

I would like to thank all those who serve on the religious school committee. They are people who are committed to the most important asset we have - our children. I owe a special debt to Cary Cherniss who often helped guide me with his expertise and knowledge as an educator.


