Between Us . . .

I came across the following piece by my friend and colleague, Rabbi Akiva Annes. I share it with you as we complete another year of Torah study and education for young and old. It is worthy of challenging us as we get ready for summer.

"Jonathan Kaufman, staff writer for the *Wall Street Journal*, has written that bigotry, especially anti-Semitism, is on the rise in America.

A half-century has passed since we discovered the calculated, cold-blooded, annotated, photographed, and meticulously recorded torture and murder of European Jewry. Museums and memorials can never overcome the atavistic bend toward hatred of the other, and in the Western world the Jew leads all others in being the other.

Some of the worlds' finest artists and thinkers have written on this subject. I share a bit with you in this season of Yom Hashoah and Yom Ha-atzmaut.

In 1939, Maritan wrote: "Anti-Semitism diverts men from the real tasks confronting them. It diverts them from the true causes of their woes."

In 1889, Tolstoy wrote: "Anti-Semitism is . . . a pathological condition, a peculiar form of sexual perversion . . . Among all disgraceful phenomena, it is the most disgusting and abominable."

In 1931, Stalin wrote: "Anti-Semitism is the most dangerous survival of cannibalism." (Who knew better?)

A certain Cohen wrote: "An anti-Semite may prove 'logically' that Jesus never existed, and may yet continue to prove 'historically' that Jews crucified him."

Ans the best response? "Jewish institutes of learning are the laboratories where weapons are forged to repel anti-Semitism. For Jews, the moral is to answer anti-Semitism with more Semitism." There is no other way - no other way."

Something to think about! Have a wonderful summer. All of us look forward to studying and learning with you in the year ahead.

Officer's Column

On May 12th I was installed as President of Anshe Emeth Memorial Temple. I would like to share with those members of the congregation who were not at Shabbat services that night some points I raised in my installation address. Not because I feel my words were so extraordinary, but because I would like those who didn't hear me to get a sense of how I feel about Anshe Emeth and our community. Additionally, I would like to share a few items that are on my agenda as President.

"The officers and trustees of your temple are people who have chosen to make this synagogue and a commitment to Judaism a central part of their lives. They are people who have chosen not to stand on the sidelines and wait for others to do it. They are people who feel a compelling need to be an integral part of the community and to live every day with that commitment. They are people who understand that without a strong, thriving, vibrant Jewish community we are not part of any community at all."

"... Since it's beginning, I have co-chaired the Tzedakah Committee with my friend, Deborah Cherniss. Nothing has given me a stronger sense of what we are as a congregation than our Tzedakah work. I have a goal of expanding our Caring Community and Tzedakah work well beyond the more than 300 people who participated last year. I am proud that one of the first events that will take place during my term is our first temple Mitzvah Day. On May 21st, more than 150 congregants will go into the community and work on projects ranging from cleaning an abandoned Jewish cemetery to planting flowers to collecting clothes for the needy. We will make Mitzvah Day an annual event and it will grow."

"I propose that in the summer of 1996 we have a Tzedakah trip to Israel. A trip where we will work side by side with Israelis on projects. Not your usual tourist trip. All trips to Israel are memorable . . . ours will be memorable not only for what we see, but for what we accomplish."

"About twelve days ago in Washington, D.C., at the Consultation of Conscience, I heard the Rev. Amos Brown speak. Rev. Brown is a black preacher from San Francisco. I cannot forget what he said he tells the children of his congregation: 'If you don't learn how to think, then someone will do your thinking for you . . . and you will forever be that person's slave.' There is a connection between education and jobs. I propose that our Social Action committee, together with the schools in the community and the local religious community establish a tutoring program. Education is probably our only way out of the current situation. Almost 90% of inmates in Federal prisons are illiterate. A program of this type has a track record in other parts of the country and it can work!"

"I urge our education committees to establish new intergenerational programs. I would like to see our senior citizens in classes with our children . . . our children in classes with their parents. Far too many of our older congregants feel excluded. If we are a congregational family, let's truly be one."

"I would like to see this sanctuary filled for many of the festivals that we do not consider major or important. Are there any minor festivals in Judaism? The answer is no. We will begin an education program leading to understanding and participation."

"To serve Anshe Emeth and the community are for me an honor and a privilege. From seeking out a religious school where we felt our sons should attend to a place where almost all our close friends are temple members, Anshe Emeth is special to my family and me . . . I look forward to working with the officers, trustees, and congregation for the next two years. You have presented us a challenge and an opportunity. However, in the end, it remains up to us to challenge ourselves. It is up to us to make the next two years one of accomplishment and commitment . . ."

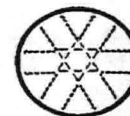
