PLANT MORPHOLOGY



Botanical Name : - Chlorophytum arundinaceum Baker

Family : - Liliaceae

Local Name :- Musali

Morphology: -

Perennial herb, with a cluster of fleshy roots. Leaves radical, linear-lanceolate, narrowed into a petiole. Scape as long as the leaves. Flowers white, in simple or shortly branched dense flowered racemes. Stamens 6; anthers as long as or longer than the filaments and yellow in colour capsule black colour.

Flowering & Fruiting: - August to October.

Uses: -

Root use as a remedy for diabetes, arthritis and increasing body immunity, curative for natal and postnatal problems, for rheumatism and joint pains, increase lactation in feeding mothers.
