11. DIRECTOR'S UPDATE

Distributed at meeting. Director indicated for the last several months, members have been kept informed about the housing needs and market assessment. Before going on maternity leave, Director asked the Commissioners to consider adoption of this as an official amendment to the County's Comprehensive Plan. She will be on their Agenda next week to request that they officially adopt this as an amendment to the Comp Plan and according to the Municipal Planning Code, there is a process that involves the Planning Commission as well. We need a recommendation from the Planning Commission which we can do at our September 17 meeting. It also requires that the Planning Commission do a public meeting and Director would like to do this before said September's meeting at 7:00 p.m. Typically, we don't see a lot of the public, but it's part of the whole advertising that we would do to get this passed as per the Municipal Planning Code. There will be the public meeting at 7:00 p.m. and then during our regular meeting, Director will ask for a recommendation from the Planning Commission to the County Commissioners endorsing that they adopt this as an official amendment. Rita and Jack looked at this for us and gave some input. It was developed in-house with input from the County Housing Taskforce. It will come in handy related to impact fees. There are some impact fees specific to housing, but they refer to having a housing plan in place in order to identify those needs. This will be good for any agency in the County that's seeking those impact dollars. Now there's an official document that they can take recommendations from for any projects related to housing when they want to go in for those funds.
