The State of the Race, 1994

WE PRIDE OURSELVES ON BEING A FULL service marathon – we want to give our runners the total experience. Therefore, at the last meeting of our Board before race day, we voted to give you a hailstorm, followed by a rainbow. The motion for snow died for lack of a second.

The law of averages finally caught up with us; after eight years of sunshine (wind two years), we finally had rain showers and even hail. It was our worst weather ever, but the runner's cards and letters are just as positive and upbeat as ever. For example:

"The weather was dreadful this year, but I had a fabulous time anyway."



Brad wasn't with us, and we still had our closest and most exciting race. Those of you who follow long distance running know that marathons are usually won at about mile 20 or 21 – and the winner cruises in a half mile ahead of number two. This year, Chad Bennion and Sammy Rotich were bouncing shoulders 20 yards from the finish. Chad had the better kick – can you imagine having a "kick" after 26.2 miles on this course? – and edged Sammy by four seconds – 2:24:36. What a treat for the crowd. That four seconds was the difference between \$5,000 and \$2,000 prize money. Seven hundred and fifty dollars a second. Pretty, popular and personable – pardon the alliteration – Kim Goff returned from Rhode Island to repeat her 1991 win, in 2:52:01, five minutes ahead of Micky Kawohl of Boca Raton and Kimball Pier of Seattle. With a repeat winner bonus, Kim flew home with \$6,000, a United Airlines ticket, Asics shoes, Thorlo Socks and lots of other swell things. She and Kimball wrote us great thank-you letters. Nice people, our elites.

The bad weather affected our numbers, as expected, both in the Marathon and the KCCN 5K. It was pouring rain all day Saturday, and we only had 50 runners sign up for the 5K instead of the anticipated 250. Only 80 signed up for the 26.2. (The Walk, as usual, sold out at 1,500, weeks before.)

We still had 2,892 registered for the Marathon (12 more than last year), and 1,678 for the KCCN 5K, (62 more). Of the 2,492 packets picked up, there were 2,244 finishers in the long event, down 71 from last year. That is 90%, which is still an impressive figure and much higher than a lot of metropolitan marathons.

The only significant complaint we had for 1994 was the back-up at the food tent at the finish. We tried a new traffic design in the finish area this year, which will be corrected in 1995.



OUR GOALS in establishing our three events were to stage world class road races and walks, raise money for charity and have a good time. We have always realized those goals, but we have discovered an element we didn't expect: our events have become a substantial motivating factor for fitness within our community.



Many of our 3,000 marathoners are from other counties and states, and they are probably in excellent shape when they sign up for our race. The 5K and Walk are different, however.

We have discovered, primarily from post race comments, that the KCCN 5K and The Walk start people on the road to fitness. For the first time, hundreds of people (50% male/female), including almost 500 children, began to think about health. They have literally discovered the joy of exercise! This new element of our activities really turns us on.



SAKHRI AZZEDDINE OF SAN FRANCISCO won the 5K in 15:02, even after a wrong turn at mile two-plus (Highway One) and he beat last year's course record holder, Ernie Freer, by 13 seconds. Ceci St. Geme of Menlo Park won the distaff side in 16:37, over one of our strongest fields ever: Maria Trujillo's 17:14, Jeanne Sapienza's 17:37 and Lynn Nelson's 17:40. Ceci broke the course record by two seconds.

We are always pleased at the fast times on our fairly difficult course. The hills and curves don't have the impact we expected.

Once again the 5K served as the championship for the USAT&F, Pacific Division.

One of the best things about our 5K race is recognizing the local schools by rewarding participation – in percentage of enrollment and highest numbers. This year's winners and their winnings for the largest percentage of its school enrollment are Captain Cooper Elementary School in Big Sur, \$1000; Colton Middle School in Monterey, \$750; and Junipero Serra School in Carmel, \$500. In the category for the highest number of entries, All Saints School in Carmel Valley was given \$1,000, Santa Catalina School in Monterey won \$750 and Carmel River School in Carmel got \$500.

Three cheers for Big Sur's Captain Cooper School (K-5) for repeating as winner of the school with the highest percentage of participation: an amazing 53%. All Saints took honors for the largest number of participants with 110 students, parents and staff members joining in the competition.



WE RAISED THE LIMIT ON THE WALK THIS YEAR to 1,500, and still sold out well before race weekend. We thought the weather would eliminate about 50-60% of



the walkers, but almost 1,300 participated! What a pleasant surprise. They stood there waiting in rain, hail and wind, some for almost two hours, cheering the marathoners at mile 10. Tough guys, our walkers.



MIKE DOVE (2:47:24) AND PATRICIA HOYOS (3:32:46), both of Salinas, were the winners of the inaugural Nancy Lesko Memorial Trophy, created to recognize Monterey County's best runners, after Nancy's marathon death last year. (We still do not know what caused her death.) Mike wrote a moving letter to our Board asking that his wife, Sue, who has a malignant brain tumor, be included with him on the new trophy (an extraordinary bronze mountain lion by Big Sur Sculptor, Loet Vanderveen). We, of course, honored his request.

As you know, we do a lot of things different from other marathons, such as providing classical music, ceramic medallions, and plastic garbage bags. We gave you report cards asking for your preferences, and then sweated out your responses. We felt that if most of you preferred the other way, such as stamped metal medallions, we would change. After over 400 cards returned, we are happy to report that you like the way we do things. At least 90% favored the choice we offered in every category – some were about 98%. THANKS.



OUR HARD LUCK STORY OF THE EVENT: David Lee, from Boulder, Colorado, our original wheelchair competitor last year, was the only wheelchair racer this year and only had to finish to win \$500.00. After half a mile he had a flat tire. Bummer.



SPEAKING OF DOING THINGS DIFFERENTLY, does any other sporting event have a naming contest? Not likely – they all seem to take themselves a little more seriously.

This year, as you know, we named Jonathon Lee's concert grand piano at Bixby Bridge. Some of the late entries and runner's up may not have heard:

"No turnin' Bach", Les Wolfson, Sunnyvale; "Middle Sea", Robert Hoerner, Cleveland; "Steinmoo", Charles Jensen, Santa Rosa, CA; "In the Key of Bix B", Paul Alarie, Thousand Oaks, CA; "Over the Hillharmonic", Mark Peterson, San Diego; "Big Sur B Flat? No." Lance Pagel, Roseville, CA (think about that one); "Phidippikeys", Alexander Stuart, Monterey; And, for the first runner-up: "Sonata Done Yet", Bill Casper, San Diego.

The winning name, you will agree, is priceless. No one before has ever been able to work in three references to classical music in one name, but Wayne Winslow, Batavia, IL, did it: "The Strauss That Baroque The Runner's Bach."



NEXT YEAR IS OUR TENTH ANNIVERSARY, and we expect to make a big bang. We are celebrating lots of things, not the least of which is our second consecutive

year of financial fitness. (We should have another \$60,000-\$80,000 net for charity, after the final bills come in.)

We are having a prize money contest, amongst professionals, for our T-Shirt design; we are adding two divisions and a 21 mile power walk. Random packets at the Expo will have very valuable prizes, including United Airline tickets, Asics shoes, subscriptions to Runner's World, etc... Random prizes will also be given away at the clinic. Stay tuned.

If you are one of our 68 Grizzled Vets (50 men, 18 women) don't miss this race: a special T-Shirt and hat for you, a group photo for posterity and our Results Books, and other treats.



Once again our favorite pair of runners, Ben Jones and Larry Wilson (a doctor and a lawyer, respectively; they are not in collusion) each gave us a \$100.00 bill as they crossed the finish line – once again passed on to Big Sur Fire Brigade and Health Center. Larry, one of our most generous benefactors because he gets nothing in return, gave us \$500.00 to use for something we wouldn't otherwise do. With that as inspiration, plus a free international ticket from United Airlines, I'm going to cover five European marathons in four weeks this fall, with entry forms, contacts with sponsors and elite

runners, etc.. It's a dirty job, but somebody... blah, blah, blah. We have a new \$100.00 donor: Richard Goven. And he didn't even get to run.

As you may have heard, we have the best Carbo party of the sport – great food, cool jazz, nice ambiance and no speeches. We sold out early last year, so sign up soon if you want to join us. Also, it's time to reserve your hotel room – we use up everything in this community. The Hyatt is our host hotel for '95 (see page 54).

Our TV shows keep getting better and better. If you didn't see it, use the order form in the back and get the extra half hour of just runners, music and scenery. This year we are adding a special treat: an 18 minute film done by Warren Masten of Palo Colorado Canyon and donated to the Marathon. You'll love his creative use of music and film.

We hope to see you next year for the Big 10. Until then, Happy Feet!

KCCN 5K State of the Race

Geoff Smith, KCCN 5K Race Director

THE KCCN 5K was initiated during a meeting of the Board of Directors three years ago in the summer of '91. Bill Burleigh, the Race Director, happened to mention that he had a conversation with George Hirsch, the publisher of *Runner's World*. It was suggested that perhaps we should add a 5K to our event, to provide a vehicle for improving the fitness of the community, and to give relatives and friends of marathoners an activity to enjoy while waiting for their long distance runners.

He asked if anyone would like to direct it, and of course, all of us being of sound mind and body said, "No!". Well...I had been the guy responsible for placing all the music on the course, i.e., the \$60,000 Yamaha grand piano at Bixby Bridge with Jonathan Lee. Two or three days had passed and I thought about it. I needed a change, something more involved, and I called Bill to tell him I would direct the 5K.

Within a week I was sitting in Bill's chambers at work, planning the logistics to put on our first race. The one thing that I'll never forget about that meeting was the comment Bill made as I was leaving the

chambers — "Geoff, I want this to be the best 5K in the state." Well, it's too late to plead temporary insanity, and here I am having completed my third year as Race Director of the KCCN 5K.

* * *

OUR INAUGURAL YEAR we had 1,199 entries of which 999 finished. Leon Panetta fired the starting gun at our first race! He's gone from being a Sixteenth District Congressman to being Chief of Staff! All for just firing our starting gun at the first 5K. And...Frank Shorter ran our first 5K. What a way to start!

Entries jumped from 1,199 to 1,616 in one year, almost a 50% increase. More importantly, 45% of the entries were out-of-county, attesting to the widespread popularity of the event. The male/female breakdown was exactly 50/50. (Bill covered the KCCN 5K highlights in his State of the Race message.)


