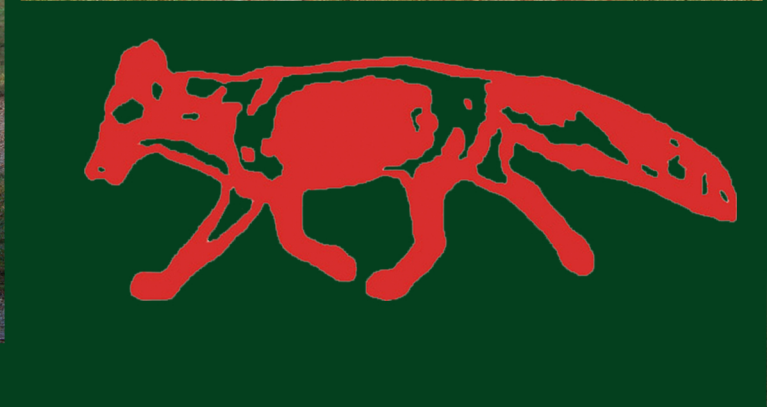

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) headline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

ENTRIES CLOSE SUNDAY, APRIL 30. Entries must be secured by an open check made payable to James River Hunt Horse Show. All entries will be responsible for a \$50 (non refundable) office fee. Any entry received after the closing date will also be subject to a \$35 late fee per horse.

Online entries will be accepted via horseshowsonline.com, however an entry will not be considered as entered in the horse show until a completed check for stall fees, and an open check to secure the account has been received.

NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS incur \$50 processing fee, plus collection costs. Unpaid entries will be forwarded to USEF per GR913.

CLASS ADDS Adds must be made in the horse show office on the official form. No fee for adds done by the evening before the class. Space permitting, class adds "the day of" will be accepted per management direction.

SHOW SCRATCHES will be accepted with a veterinary certificate, however stall and office fees are nonrefundable. *\$35 fee for show scratches without a veterinary certificate.*

CLASS SCRATCHES Scratches must be made in the horse show office on the official form. No fee for scratches made in the office anytime before the division begins. *Horses/riders entered but not exhibited, but not scratched before the first class of the division, the exhibitor shall be responsible for the entry fees.*

NUMBER PICKUP: Before receiving numbers, all participants (rider, handler, trainer, agent or lessee) must present their current USEF and USHJA membership cards, or a copy to the show secretary.

Per USEF GR844 proof of vaccination for horses, more than 7 months of age, entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and EHV vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request.

Virginia State Law requires each horse on the show grounds to have a negative Coggins dated within one year, a copy must be submitted to the show office. Exhibitors are encouraged to submit their Coggins with entry blanks.

Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Every horse entered in classes must pay the \$15 USEF Drug/Medication Fee plus an \$8 USEF fee. Every horse must also pay the USHJA Fee of \$7.

Exhibitors should be prepared to show valid USEF/USHJA credentials for themselves and their horses. Any horse or pony not possessing a valid measurement card must be measured by the show steward prior to competing in their respective division. Exhibitors who cannot produce verification of USEF and/or USHJA membership will be charged a nonrefundable \$45 (USEF)/\$30 (USHJA) show pass fee. **Note:** A USEF Show Pass must be purchased through USEF.ORG, and only one per year is allowed. Amateurs must possess a valid amateur card or must join Federation. Only a parent will be exempt from Show Pass fees if signing as a coach for his/her minor child. Refer to USEF.ORG for microchip requirements.

STABLING: Stalls are limited!

- Stall fees are \$225 (*nonrefundable*) per stall with no initial bedding provided.
- There is a \$5 per horse night watch fee.
- Horses with stalls not entered in classes will be charged a \$100 non-showing fee.
- Ship ins are permitted and will pay a \$50 grounds fee.
- Non showing horses are permitted, but must complete and sign an entry blank and provide a valid Coggins. A \$100 non showing horse fee will apply.
- 100 permanent stalls that are 10x10 supplemented by solid-side vinyl canvas portable stalls (if entries warrant) with self supporting roof, all with lights and doors available Thursday May 11-Sunday May, 14. Specific stabling requests will be considered but not guaranteed.
- Stalls belong to the James River Hunt Horse Show, and must be reserved through the secretary. Stall assignments will be made by the Stable Manager, and any changes must be authorized by them. ***The James River Hunt Horse Show reserves the right to use stalls more than once.*** Feed, Hay and bedding will be available for purchase on the show grounds.
- Permanent stalls have floor mats or packed ground with metal grates. Portable stalls have grass floors with metal doors.
- Exhibitors will be held responsible for damages or alterations to stalls, including punctures. If unsure, show manager should be consulted; otherwise charges for any damage or alteration will be billed to exhibitor on record.

PARKING: All cars, vans and trailers must be parked in designated areas only. Vans and trailers may not be parked in the stable area. Exhibitors must observe Fire Lane regulations. Vans and trailers bringing animals for the day are required to park in a specified area where water will be available.

CAMPERS: A limited number of camper spaces with water and electrical (30 Amp) hook-ups are available for \$75/night. Contact Michelle Hawley (757)676-8656 for availability.

MEDICAL WASTE: Sharps containers will be provided at the barns. Exhibitors are responsible for properly disposing of waste or risk incurring fines or other penalties as determined by the show manager.

DOGS Dogs must on leashes while on Show Grounds, owners who fail to comply may be subject to fines. Owners must have evidence of their dog's current rabies vaccination.

MANAGEMENT STATEMENT

James River Hunt Horse Show is recognized by USEF, VHSA. Any questions or disputes which arise that are not specifically provided for shall be referred to the show committee whose decision shall be final. While every effort has been made to avoid mistakes in this publication USEF, James River Hunt Horse Show and it's management and/or employees assume no liability for errors. The Committee reserves the right to postpone, reschedule, combine or cancel any class or classes if in its judgement the entries are inadequate for reasons of inclement weather or dangerous conditions or for any other reasons it deems necessary. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry and other fees. The Committee reserves the right to prohibit any persons from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the Show without being liable for compensation. No person will be allowed in the rings during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those who have official or requested duties to perform. Neither the Committee and horse show employees nor Deep Run Hunt Club and employees will be responsible for any accident which may occur to any rider, groom, attendant, animal or equipment at the show. Parent(s) or guardians of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and the Facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless the entry is signed by a parent or legal guardian.

SAFESPORT STATEMENT

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF SafeSport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information can be found at www.use.org.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and

other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book, VHSA, and USHJA rule books will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Three entries are required to fill a class unless otherwise specified. Classes will be combined or split in accordance with current USEF rules.

JOG: Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion.

AWARDS

Ribbons will be given for 1-8 in all classes unless otherwise specified.

PRIZE MONEY will be credited to show accounts, any prize money overages will be mailed to the payee listed on the entry blank within 30 days of checkout. Social security information must be provided for any animal entered in classes with prize money.

SCHOOLING

Rings are 150' x 275' with all weather footing. \$40 per horse ticketed warmups with back numbers will be offered on Thursday, May 11 from 8:30 am - 4:30 pm in the Grandstand Ring and 9:00 am - 5:00 pm in the Eastern Meadows ring. **After May 11 there will be no schooling over fences in the ring at any time, or schooling at the end of the show day.** At management's discretion, flatwork and hand walking may be allowed up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the show each morning. Separate warmup areas will be provided. Warmup areas are both natural turf and all weather footing.

It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. James River Hunt Horse Show is introducing a new perpetual trophy this year, the **James River Hunt Master's Trophy** *in memory of June and Tommy Clark, MFH*. As horse lovers,



they were long time members of James River Hunt. They enjoyed spending time with fellow hunt members as well as hosting hunt events. Tommy hunted until he was 90 years old, and was a Master of Foxhounds (MFH) until his death in 2020. He attended over 50 consecutive years of the fox hunting tradition, The Blessing of the Hounds. The trophy is being donated by James River Hunt, and will be awarded to the Champion of the James River Hunter Division.

Long time members have many fond memories of June and Tommy which, they continue to share with newer members. Pictures of June and Tommy adorn the walls in the tack area of their horse trailer that has been passed to the current MFH, and can be seen when greeting the master on hunt mornings. Even today, a part of June and Tommy join when riding to hounds.

The Star Meadow Dragonfly Horsemanship Award will be presented yearly to the junior or amateur rider who most exhibits the following traits. They will be someone who personally commits to the time and effort needed to care for their horse in a thoughtful and respectful manner. They demonstrate patience and persistence when things aren't easy while at the same time remaining humble and open minded. They are aware and attentive to the horse's body language and general well-being and prove daily that the needs of their horse are superior to the excitement of winning a ribbon. These are traits that were required of any rider worthy of the original Star Meadow Dragonfly.

Mr. Pony, as he was lovingly referred to, was discovered as a 7-year-old project pony and was quickly molded into a forever pony. From up down lessons to 3-foot pony hunters, he went on to teach many riders what horsemanship is truly about. This award is given in loving memory of Star Meadow Dragonfly by Elizabeth Saunders, who feels so grateful to have plucked this pony out of the pasture many years ago.

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian (“USEF”) allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ (“USEF Event” or “USEF Events”); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the “Agreement”):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers (“Risks”).

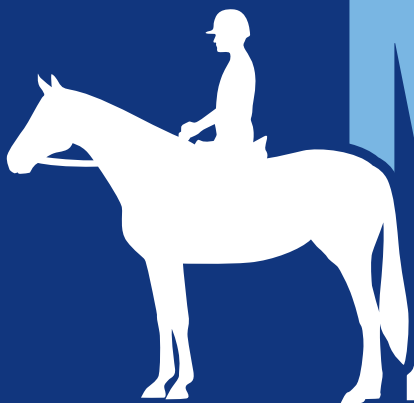
