

Tom Berman Award \$1000

Tom Berman was a University of Michigan film student, and an early supporter and close friend of the festival. His brilliant early films won many awards. He was much loved here. In his memory, an annual award of \$1000 is given to "the Most Promising Filmaker in the Festival". All films submitted to the festival are eligible for this

Marvin Felheim Award \$100

Marvin Feldheim was one of the founders of the Ann Arbor Film Festival. As a film scholar at the University of Michigan, his wisdom and strength guided the festival for seventeen years. He was both benefactor and critic, but most of all, our friend. His contributions to the festival are commemorated by this annual award.

Lawrence Kasdan Award \$250
