



Day 1

Wednesday 3rd June

Weather: Fine & sunny with a breeze at Heathrow. Warm & bright, Funchal

All 8 tour participants met Paul, the trip leader, at Gatwick Airport for the 16.20pm Air Portugal flight to Funchal. On arrival we were met by our driver for the week, Jose. From the airport we then made our way to Funchal and our accommodation for the next seven days, the Residencial Pina. After finding our rooms and settling in, we met in the hotel cafe and Paul gave us a brief outline of the week before we retired for the night.

Day 2

Thursday 4th June

Weather: Warm & sunny on south side of island, cloudy on the north

From Funchal we drove east to Cancela, where we made a brief stop to buy our picnic lunch. Then we continued north to Camacha, on up over the central ridge at Paso de Poiso and down to Ribeiro Frio (lit. 'cold river'). When we arrived we made a short tour of a small public garden where we saw *Musschia wollastonii* (Wollaston's Musschia), *Goodyeara macrophylla* (Madeiran Goodyeara) and *Ranunculus cortusifolius* ssp. *grandiflorus* (Madeiran Buttercup). From here we walked the western of the two Levadas to the look out point at Balcoes, as we went we had superb views of Madeiran Firecrest and Madeiran Chaffinch, as well as *Laurus azorica* (Azores Laurel), *Geranium palmatum* (Anemone-leaved Crane's-bill) and *Melanoselinum dicipliens*.

For lunch, we made our way up towards the Piro do Arieiro (1,818 metres), the island's third highest peak, where we stopped at a picnic site among some *Pinus pinaster* (Maritime Pine). Siskins were heard and a Common Buzzard seen as well as *Spartium junceum* (Spanish Broom). In the afternoon we returned to Ribeiro Frio to walk the Portela Levada. Here we recorded Robin and Madeiran Firecrest again, as well as *Asplenium monanthes* (a Spleenwort), *Ruscus stenophyllum* (a Butcher's-broom), *Adiantum capillis-veneris* (Maiden-hair Fern) and *Dactylorhiza foliosus* (Madeiran Orchid). After a short stop to enjoy a welcoming coffee, we made the return journey to Funchal. In the evening we made our first visit to the Restaurante Combatentes for dinner.

Day 3

Friday 5th June

Weather: Cloudy with sunny periods, some heavy rain at first.

Today we again drove east to Cancela where we visited the supermarket before continuing towards the Ponta de Sao Louenco, via Machico.

First we made a short stop at Prainha where we found Atlantic Yellow-legged Gull and had superb, close views of a Berthelot's Pipit. Among the plants we had *Lotus glaucus* (Smooth Bird's-foot Trefoil), *Psoralia bituminosa* (Pitch Trefoil) and *Cenchrus ciliaris* (Buffle Grass).

From here we made the final short hop to the Ponta de Sao Louenco, where we took a walk out towards the point. Again, we saw Berthelot's Pipit and heard the elusive Common Quail. Meanwhile, the plants included *Helichrysum devium* (Everlasting), *Scolomus maculatus* (Golden Thistle) and *Andrayala glandulosa* subsp. *glandulosa* (Andrayala). A good number of the cricket *Decticus albifrons*, Brassica Bug and the splendid Orb-web Spider *Agriope trifasciata* were seen, and we were also treated to a Common Tern mobbing a Common Buzzard.

It was now time for our picnic, so we made our way back to Prainha to set up our lunch. Berthelot's Pipit and Kestrel were noted during the meal. After lunch we made our way to the old whaling town of Canicel. Here we explored some of the rock pools and took a leisurely stroll along the sea coast road, stopping for refreshments. We saw Spanish Sparrows, Grey Wagtail and a small flock of Common Waxbills, as well as *Arundo donax* (Giant Reed) and *Bidens pilosa* var. *minor* (a bur-marigold). A solitary Monarch Butterfly was also spotted. Leaving Canicel, we made a short stop at a viewpoint called Pico do Facho, before making our way back towards Cancela. Here we came to see the *Musschia aurea* (Golden Musschia) and *Trachelium caeruleum* (Throatwort). From here it was a fairly short trip back, through the old town of Funchal, to the Residential Pina, in time prepare for dinner. Tonight we ate at La Riviera Restaurante.

Day 4

Saturday 6th June

Weather: Cloudy at first, becoming warm, dry & sunny, clouding over again later.

Our objective today was to walk the path to the Pico Ruivo, at 1,862 metres, the highest point on the island. After shopping for our picnic lunch at Cancela, we drove east to Machico, before turning north through the new road tunnel system to Faial and Santana. Here we turned south-west, aiming for the base of the Pico Ruivo. As we approached the car park, we emerged from low cloud into bright sunshine with amazing views of the rugged peaks in a cloud-scape. The path is very well marked and we set off at a slow steady pace. Along the way we found *Mentha puligium* (Pennyroyal), *Ranunculus cortusifolius* ssp. *minor* (a buttercup), *Erica maderensis* (Madeiran Heather), *Erica arborea* (Tree Heather) and *Viola paradoxa* (Madeiran Wild Pansy). Birds included Robin, Plain Swift, a single Pallid Swift and Berthelot's Pipit. Near the summit, we stopped at the 'Refugio' for some well-earned refreshments, while some of the group completed the last section to the summit, which rewarded them with stunning panoramic views of the upper parts of the island. On our return to the car park, we set up our picnic under the canopy of the car park lodge. Here, Maderian Wall Lizards were very plentiful.

For our descent, we made our way down to Santana, where we made a brief visit to some traditional Madeiran houses, before making our way to Porto da Cruz. Along the way we stopped at a viewpoint to photograph the stunning views. Here we saw *Rumex maderensis* (Madeiran Sorrel), *Plantago arborescens* (Maderian Plantain) and *Misopates orontium* (Weasel Snout). Kestral was seen and Common Buzzard heard. A final short stop at Porto da Cruz added *Matthiola maderense* (Madeiran Stock) and Plain Swifts and Lesser Black-backed Gulls on an adjacent sea stack, together with Atlantic Yellow-legged Gulls. The final leg of the journey took us near Machico before turning west back to Funchal, and dinner was taken at the Restaurante Arco.

Day 5

Sunday 7th June

Weather: Fine, warm & sunny

Today we headed to the north and west of the island. Leaving Funchal we drove west towards Ribeiro Brava, turning off the motorway at Campasnario, where we stopped at a 'Miradouro' (view point) to see the last two Dragon Trees (*Dracena draco*) still native on the island. Here, we also found *Olea europaea* ssp. *maderensis* (Madeiran Olive) and two spiders, *Argiope trifasciata* and the Comunual Orb Web, *Cyrtophora citricola*. From here we descended to Ribeira Brava, before travelling north to Sao Vicente. Our objective for the morning was to explore the splendid sea cliffs that dominate this part of the coast. Our first stop gave the group some clear views of Common Tern and Atlantic Yellow-legged Gull, as well as some distant glimpses of Trocaz pigeon and Common Buzzard. Plants included *Aeonium glandulosum* (Disc Houseleek), *Aichryson divaricatum* and *Aichryson villosum*, *Echium nervosum* (Small Pride of Madeira), *Plantago leiopetala* and *Samolus valerandi* (Brookweed).

Continuing west to Seixal, we turned into a small valley called Chao da Ribeiro and began by exploring the upper reaches of the valley, getting several more fleeting glimpses of the Trocaz Pigeon. Also seen were Blackcap and Canary; Madeiran Brimstone and European and Macaronesian Red Admiral were added to the growing butterfly list. We also found *Saxifraga maderensis* var. *maderensis* (Madeiran Saxifrage) *Helichrysum foetidum* (Fetid Everlasting), Myrica faya (Wax Myrtle) and *Teline maderensis* (Shrub Trefoil).

After taking our picnic in this lovely spot we continued along the coast. A brief stop at a viewpoint added *Euphorbia piscatoria* (Smooth Spear-leaved Spurge) and a Common Teal in the river below, before we continued on to Porto Moniz. The magnificent coastal lava flows here are home to a large colony of *Helichrysum obconicum* (Everlasting). After indulging in ice-creams and coffee, we set off back towards Funchal.

Our return journey took us along the eastern side of the Ribeira da Janela and through some of the most unspoiled laurisilva (Laurel Forest) habitat to be seen on the island. Passing through Fanal, and on over the Paul da Serra and down to Encumeada, before retracing our steps east from Ribeira Brava toward Funchal, making our final stop of the day at the spectacular sea cliff at Cabo Girao – at 580 metres it is the second highest example in the world. Dinner was again taken at the Restaurante Arco.

Day 6

Monday 8th June

Weather: Fine warm & sunny

Today the group was free to choose their own activities. Most of the group decided to begin the day at the Botanical Gardens in Funchal. This was a good choice as they were able to see some of the endemic plant species which we had not managed to find in a native situation. They also saw several Perez's Frogs in the water features. The rest of the day was spent as each group member chose.

Three tour members joined Paul for the two and a half hour sea crossing to Porto Santo. After an early breakfast, we were collected by our taxi and take to the Harbour to embark on the 'Lobo Marinho' (Wolf of the Sea – Monk Seal). In the harbour Atlantic Yellow-legged Gulls and Common Terns were seen.

The boat left Funchal at 08-00hrs and almost immediately we were being treated to a wonderful aerial display by Cory's Shearwaters. During the crossing we also saw Bulwer's Petrel and Manx Shearwater. There were also several sightings of Bottle-nosed Dolphins.

Upon our arrival at Porto Santo, we were met by a driver, who immediately took us to the far southwest corner of the island, to Ponta da Calheta. Here we explored the sand dunes and scrub before lunch. Spanish Sparrows, Rock Sparrows and Hoopoe were recorded and a fleeting glimpse of a Spectacled Warbler was had. Plants included *Lotus glaucus* (Maderian Bird's-foot Trefoil), *Euphorbia paralias* (Sea Spurge) and *Euphorbia peplis* (Purple Spurge) were also recorded. The afternoon was spent taking a tour of the island with our driver and guide, Karina. We visited the Miradouro das Flores, Campo de Cima, Vereda da Fonte da Areia, Camacha and Portela. Along the way we saw Rock Sparrow, Grey Heron, Spanish Sparrow, Kestrel and a good number of Hoopoes, as well as *Cynara cardunculus* (Cardoon) and *Limonium sinuatum* (Garden Sea Lavander), before returning to the harbour at 19-00hrs for the return sea crossing to Funchal, arriving at 21-15hrs.

Day 7

Tuesday 9th June

Weather: Cloudy with rain early, becoming fine, warm & sunny

Our last full day was spent in the central highlands of Madeira. Travelling west towards Ribeiro Brava, we made a short stop for picnic provisions, before traveling north via Serra de Agua to Encumeada, where we walked the Folhadal Levada. Here we had some good views of Madeiran Wall Lizards as well as seeing *Euphorbia mellifera* (Melliferous Spurge), *Ilex perado* ssp. *perado* (Madeiran Holly), *Persia indica* (Madeiran Mahogany) and *Apollonias barbujana* (Canary Laurel). Common Buzzard and Robin were also seen.

We then headed west up to the Paul da Serra and on to Rabacal. It is no longer possible to take a vehicle down to the Casa do Rabacel, so we had to begin our walk at the main road. Going along the old road, we made our way down to the 'Refugio', for our picnic. On the way we had wonderful views of Madeiran Firecrest and Perez's Frog.

After lunch we walked on to Risco, where we were fortunate enough to get some great views of the elusive Trocاز Pigeon, Robin and Chaffinch, and admire the stunning scenery. From Risco, we continued down and south along 'Levada of the 25 Fontes' (25 springs) to a tunnel. This took us through the mountainside emerging to the south of Rabacal, where Jose was waiting for us. Along the way we saw *Sonchus frutescens* (Large Sowthistle), *Erica scoparius* (Small Green-flowered Heath) and *Sibthorpia perigrina* (Madeiran Moneywort). Upon our return to Funchal, we bid farewell to Jose, thanking him for all he had done for us throughout the week. Our final dinner of the tour was taken at the Restaurante Combatentes.

Day 8

Wednesday 10th June

Weather: Bright, warm & sunny at Funchal. Cloudy with some sun, Gatwick

We departed the Residencial Pina at 9.30am and made the drive to the airport, arriving at 10.00am for our flight home. We landed safely at Gatwick at 3.15pm.
