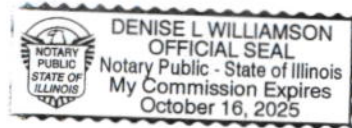



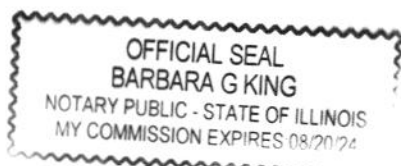

WHEREAS, the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor was created to provide services to State's Attorneys in Counties containing less than 3,000,000 inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, the powers and duties of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor are defined and enumerated in the "State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor's Act", 725 ILCS 210/1 et seq., as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly appropriates monies for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, one-third from the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor's County Fund and two-thirds from the General Revenue Fund, provided that such funding receives approval and support from the respective Counties eligible to apply; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor shall administer the operation of the appellate offices so as to insure that all participating State's Attorneys continue to have final authority in preparation, filing, and arguing of all appellate briefs and any trial assistance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ford County Board, in regular session, this ____ day of _____, 20____ does hereby support the continued operation of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, and designates the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor as its Agent to administer the operation of the appellate offices and process said appellate court cases for this County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attorneys employed by the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor are hereby authorized to act as Assistant State's Attorneys on behalf of the State's Attorney of this County in the appeal of all cases when requested to do so by the State's Attorney, and with the advice and consent of the State's Attorney, prepare, file, and argue appellate briefs for those cases; and also, as may be requested by the State's Attorney, to assist in the prosecution of cases under the Illinois Controlled Substances Act, the Cannabis Control Act, the Drug Asset Forfeiture Procedure Act, and the Narcotics Profit Forfeiture Act. Such attorneys are further authorized to assist the State's Attorney in the trial and appeal of tax objections.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor will offer Continuing Legal Education training programs to the State's Attorneys and Assistant State's Attorneys.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attorneys employed by the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor may also assist the State's Attorney of this County in the discharge of the State's Attorney's duties in the prosecution and trial of other cases, and may act as Special Prosecutor if duly appointed to do so by a court having jurisdiction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor is duly appointed to act as a Special Prosecutor in this County by a court having jurisdiction, this County will provide reasonable and necessary clerical and administrative support and victim-witness coordination on an as-needed basis and will also cover all reasonable and necessary case expenses such as expert witness fees, transcripts, evidence presentation, documents, lodgings, and all other expenses directly related to the prosecution of the case.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Ford County Board hereby agrees to participate in the service program of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, commencing December 1, 2021 and ending November 30, 2022, by hereby appropriating the sum of \$4,500.00 as consideration for the express purpose of providing a portion of the funds required for financing the operation of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, and agrees to deliver the same to the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor on request during the stated twelve month period.

SUMMARY OF MATERIAL MODIFICATIONS

CAFETERIA PLAN

This is a Summary of Material Modifications (SMM) regarding the Ford County Cafeteria Plan (the "Plan"). This Summary of Material Modifications supplements and amends the Summary Description (SD) previously provided to you. You should retain this document with Your copy of the SD.

This SMM describes certain temporary provisions adopted by Your Employer for the Plan to implement certain optional relief provisions made available pursuant to the Taxpayer Certainty and Disaster Tax Relief Act of 2020, enacted as part of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 (the "CAA"), related IRS Notice 2021-15 (the "Notice"), and the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 ("ARPA"). This SMM also explains certain temporary changes to COBRA timelines (EBSA Disaster Relief Notices 2020-01 and 2021-01).

Cafeteria Plan Election Relief

For plan years ending in 2021, you will have an opportunity to prospectively: (1) make a new election for employer-sponsored health coverage on a prospective basis if you initially declined to elect employer-sponsored health, dental, or vision coverage ("health coverage"); (2) revoke an existing election for employer-sponsored health coverage and make a new election to enroll in different health coverage sponsored by Your Employer (including an election to change enrollment from self-only coverage to family coverage); or (3) subject to providing a written attestation (in the form required by Your Employer) that You are enrolled in, or immediately will enroll in, other comprehensive health coverage not sponsored by Your Employer, revoke an existing election for employer-sponsored health coverage.

COBRA and Continuation Matters

In accordance with ARPA, Assistance Eligible Individuals ("AEI") (as defined below and consistent with ARPA) may be eligible to receive up to six months of fully subsidized continuation coverage (as provided for under federal COBRA or similar state continuation coverage law) in connection with employer-sponsored health coverage for continuation coverage periods between April 1, 2021 and September 30, 2021.

AEIs include employees and former employees (and their dependents) who lose health coverage or who have lost coverage in the past 18 months due to a reduction in hours or an involuntarily termination of employment for reasons other than gross misconduct. AEIs are eligible for subsidized COBRA coverage so long as the maximum COBRA coverage period otherwise applicable to them does not expire before April 1, 2021.

ARPA does not extend or change the period of continuation coverage that an individual is entitled to under COBRA. Rather, ARPA provides that the cost of all, or any portion of, a period of

continuation coverage which an individual is already entitled to that occurs between April 1, 2021 and September 30, 2021 may be eligible to be fully subsidized.

Separate notices providing additional details on eligibility and procedures for electing subsidized COBRA coverage in connection with employer sponsored health coverage will be (have been) provided to potentially eligible participants and dependents by the Plan Administrator as required by ARPA. Subsidized COBRA coverage will not be provided unless it is elected by an AEI as set forth in such notices.




