Leopard Cast Iron Plant







Aspidistra minutiflora 'Leopard'

- <u>Use:</u> Makes a stunning specimen for the woodland garden in the Deep South and a great house plant further north. . Excellent for those difficult to fill areas in deep shade like under a porch or stairs. Spreads by underground stems. Deer resistant. Super tough! Fairly drought tolerant too once established!
- **<u>Exposure/Soil</u>**: Part sun– shade; moist, well drained soil. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- *Growth*: Makes an attractive clump of 30" tall and wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 8a-10b; Shrub; also makes a great houseplant
- <u>Foliage</u>: Evergreen. Narrow, ribbon-like leaves only 0.5" wide. Each green leaf is heavily speckled with large golden spots.
- *Flower:* Insignificant brownish-purple flowers in spring.
