#### **GROUNDCOVERS & VERY LOW GROWERS**

MYOPORUM PARVIFOLIUM 'Boobialla'



Prostrate x W.1.5m Lush groundcover with pale pink star flowers mainly in spring. Will root at the nodes as is spreads. Full sun to semi-shade. Effective as a spill-over as well. Tumblers \$5 each

Chrysocephalum apiculatum – 'Velvet Grey'.



Prostrate x W.1.5m

A stunning soft, grey-foliaged groundcover with bright yellow pom-pom type flowers from early spring. Best in an open, sunny spot. Very hardy once established. Best to remove dead flowers.

This form is not widely available. 6"/140mm pots \$10 each

BRACHYCOME PACIFIC REEF



Prostrate x W.1.5m

Striking groundcover with bright pink 'daisy' flowers most of the year. Full sun to semi-shade and suckers over time to fill a larger area. Keep well watered during dry spells. Tumblers \$5 each

#### CHRYSOCEPHALUM APICULATUM



Prostrate x W.1.5m A very tough groundcover with dense foliage and bright yellow 'button' type flowers most of the year. Suckers as it spreads. Full sun to semi-shade. Can suffer in extended dryness but always bounces back. Tumblers \$5 each

Austromyrtus dulcis - Midgen Berry



H. 30cm x W 2m. Wonderful bush-tucker plant & effective ground cover with small white flowers followed by delightful edible berries. Full sun to heavy shade & very hardy. Fruit often sought by Bower Birds. Tumblers \$5 each

#### HELICHRYSUM SILVER DOME



H.20 x W.1m Just like a grey dome with soft, downy foliage & small, white flowers late winter & spring. Best in ample sun and extremely hardy & drought tolerant. Tumblers \$5 each

#### Goodenia ovata



Prostrate x 1.5m Groundcover with glossy, almost succulent foliage & masses of yellow flowers mainly spring. Very hardy in reasonable drainage and suitable in shade to full sun. Tumblers \$5 each

#### PULTENAEA PEDUNCULATA



Compact groundcover 1m across with lush foliage & masses of small yellow flowers early spring. Full sun to semi-shade. Very hardy. Suits a hanging basket. Tumblers \$5 each

#### Scaevola aemula Bombay



Trailing groundcover with masses of bright pink fan-shaped flowers spring to summer. Full sun to semi-shade. Cut back as necessary. Easily propagated from cuttings. Tumblers \$5 each

#### Thryptomene repens



Prostrate W. 1.5m Low-growing shrub from Shark Bay, WA with small pink flowers; best in good drainage & ample sun. Tends to root at the nodes as it spreads. Not widely available Tumblers \$5 each

#### Grevillea thelemmiana – Form



H.40cm x W.2.5m Dense semi-prostrate spreading shrub with deeply divided leaves & bright red flowers winter to summer. Hardy in reasonable drainage & best in ample sun. Great for birds. Can be pruned heavily. Tumblers \$5 each

#### Dampiera trigona



H.0.3m x W.0.3m Low, weeping plant with masses of purple flowers through spring. Best in a sheltered spot with reasonable drainage. Very attractive in flower. Tumblers \$5 each

#### HIBBERTIA PEDUNCULATA



Prostrate x W. 1m Compact groundcover with intricate foliage & masses of bright yellow flowers ten cent piece size early spring to summer. Full sun to semi shade. Tumblers \$5 each

### DARWINIA TAXIFOLIA 'Dinkum Devil'



Prostrate x W.1.5m Denise groundcover with grey/green foliage and masses of red, upright flowers during winter & spring. Lovely in flower and takes sun or semi-shade and hardy once established. Not widely available **Tumblers \$5 each** 

#### ISOTOMA AXILLARIS Fizz N' Pop



H.0.3m x W.0.5m Stunning low-growing plant with bright green foliage & masses of star-shaped pink flowers spring to autumn. Full sun to semi-shade. Great in a pot 6"/140mm pots \$15 each

#### SMALL SHRUBS TO 1m

Chorizema cordatum (WA Flame Pea)



H.1m x W.1.5m

This plant provides great colour for a shaded or semi-shaded spot late winter to spring. Prune after flowering and protect from snails. A W.A. beauty that does well over this side. Stunning in flower.

#### HIBBERTIA VESTITIA



H.30cm W.50cm A small shrub with dark green intricate foliage & masses of bright yellow flowers ten cent piece size early spring to summer. Full sun to semi shade. Works well as a pot plant Tumblers \$5 each.

#### SENNA ARTEMISOIDES



H. 1m x W.1.m Rounded shrub with lace-like grey foliage and masses of yellow pea flowers late winter & spring. Very hardy in good drainage & loves a hot spot. Can be pruned heavily after flowering. Tumblers \$5 each

THRYPTOMENE CALYCINA



H. 1m W. 1m Upright shrub with masses of tiny white flowers aging pink late winter & spring. From full sun to semi-shade in good drainage. Excellent cut flower. Tumblers \$5 each

#### EUTAXIA OBOVATA



H.50cm x W.1.5m Low, spreading shrub with masses of yellow and orange pea flowers in spring. Full sun to semi-shade. Only a short flowering period but spectacular in flower.. Tumblers \$5 each

#### CALYTRIX TETRAGONA



H. 1m W.1m Upright shrub with fine foliage & bright pink, fluffy flowers in Spring. Full sun to semi-shade in reasonable drainage. Has a short flowering period but magnificent. Tumblers \$5 each

Homoranthus prolixus – Golditops



H: 50cm W: 1m Low, spreading shrub with grey foliage & masses of bright yellow flowers across the top from mid spring. Outstanding plant in ample sun. Needs winter sun to set buds. Not widely available Tumblers \$5 each

#### GREVILLEA BUTTERFLY BEAUTY (fililoba x hirtella)



H.1m W.1.5m Spreading shrub with soft foliage and pendulous red flowers most of the year. Best in ample sun with good drainage & great for birds. Just registered with the Australian Cultivar Registration Authority and not available elsewhere. Tumblers \$5 each

#### Crowea Festival



H. 1m W.1m Rounded shrub with masses of pink star-shaped flowers mid-summer into autumn. Full sun to dappled shade & good drainage. Great as cut flower. Tumblers \$5 each

#### Crowea exalata Green Cape



Prostrate x 1m

A delightful low-growing form of Crowea exalata suited from full sun to semi-shade in reasonable drainage. Reasonably hardy and eagerly sought by native bees Tumblers \$5 each

#### BORONIA CRENULATA



H:40cm W:50cm Rounded shrub with very aromatic foliage & masses of soft pink star flowers through the year. Best in a sheltered spot and avoid drying out. An outstanding pot plant. Tumblers \$5 each

EREMOPHILA GLABRA ssp. Carnosa



H.0.5m x W.1.5m

Dense, spreading shrub with bright green leaves and orange/yellow tubular flowers from winter to summer. Hardy once established and drought tolerant. Good for birds. Not widely available

#### MICROMYRTUS CILIATA



H.70cm x W.1.5m Delightful low, spreading shrub with horizontal growth and very aromatic foliage. Pure white flowers from late winter that age to pink. Local to Sydney area. Full sun to dappled shade. A great feature plant. Tumblers \$5 each

DARWINEA CITRIODORA 'Darwin's Delight'



H.1m W.1.5m Rounded shrub with blue/green, aromatic foliage & exceptionally large orange & yellow flowers mainly in spring. Full sun to semi-shade & will accept poor drainage. Tumblers \$5



H.0.5m W.1m

Low growing form with attractive lush foliage & bright red orchid-like flowers mainly winter and spring. Best in fairly sunny spot. Favoured by honey-eater birds. Tumblers \$5 each or 6"/140mm pots \$10 each

Maireana oppositifolia – Bluebush



H.1m x W.1.5m An outstanding foliage plant with blue/grey tightly packed leaves. Thrives in very hot & dry spots once established. Prune occasionally to keep compact. Tumblers \$5 each

#### Bauera rubioides x sessiliflora



30cm x W.1.5m Low, spreading plant with soft foliage & masses of bright pink, cupped flowers mainly in spring. Best in a sheltered spot and will accept poor drainage. Not widely available. Tumblers \$5 each

#### Thryptomene Saxicola



H.1m W.1.5m Spreading shrub with a weeping habit. Has fine foliage & masses of small pink flowers late winter into spring. Full sun to semi-shade & very hardy once established.

## CORREA PULCHELLA 'Firebird



H.1m x W.1.5m

Rounded shrub with lovely pendulous red/ orange bells mainly in autumn & winter. Best in semi-shade & good drainage. Also great for the birds. Prune to shape after flowering Tumblers \$5 each or 6"/140mm pots \$10 each

#### ZIERIA CYTISOIDES 'Grey Ghost'



H.1m x W.1m

Upright plant with soft grey foliage & light pink flowers mid-winter to spring. Quite hardy once established and best in a sheltered or even shady spot. Tumblers \$5 each

CERATOPETALUM JOHANNA'S CHRISTMAS Dwarf NSW Xmas Bush



H.1.5m x W.1.5m

Rounded shrub with dense foliage & small, cream/white flowers late spring followed by brilliant red sepals at Christmas time. Best in a fairly sunny spot. Very hardy and an excellent pot plant. Very limited availability at this time in the market place, although in large numbers from Westleigh Native Plants.

#### Eremophila racemosa (Emu Bush)



H.1.5m W.1m

Upright shrub with lush mid-green foliage and masses of orange buds followed by pink orchid-like flowers late winter and spring. Best in ample sun & suits hot dry, spot. Great for birds. Tumblers \$5 each

#### Prostanthera phylicifolia – Mint Bush



H.1.m W.1m Dense shrub with masses of purple flowers early spring. Great plant for a sunny or shady spot in reasonable drainage. Very hardy. Can be pruned heavily after flowering to keep compact. 6"/140mm pots \$10 each

#### CHAMELAUCIUM REVELATION



1.5m x 0.5m with pine-like foliage & flowers opening white & fading to soft mauve late winter & spring. Best in ample Sun & good drainage. Tumblers \$5 each

Grevillea Spider Mist (G.Fireworks x arenaria)



H.1.5m x W.1.5m Rounded shrub with soft grey/green foliage and orange & yellow 'spider' flowers winter to spring. Dense shrub & can be pruned into a hedge. Very hardy & great for birds. Only available from Westleigh Native Plants. A registered cultivar by WNP Tumblers \$5 each

#### Grevillea Honey Jo (G.sericea x linearifolia)



H.1.5m W.1.0m An upright shrub with fine foliage & masses of highly honey-perfumed 'spider' flowers from mid-winter to mid-summer. From full sun to semi-shade in free draining soil. Not widely available and a registered cultivar by Westleigh Native Plants. Tumblers \$5 each

#### EREMOPHILA COMPLANATA 'Chinnock'



H.1.5m W.1m

Upright, open shrub with soft, fine foliage and lovely pinkish or purple flowers mainly in spring. Loves a hot, dry spot and it is very good as a cut flower. Tumblers \$5 each

#### CHAMELAUCIUM WALPOLE WAX Pink Form



#### H.1.5m W.1m

Form of Geraldton Wax. Upright shrub with fine foliage & masses of pink flowers late winter into spring. Needs ample sun & great in a vase. Can be heavily pruned if necessary. Tumblersd \$5 each

#### CHAMELAUCIUM x VERTICORDIA PADDYS' PINK



#### H.1.5m W.1m

Hybrid between Geraldton Wax and Verticordia with masses of small pink flowers for months through spring. Best in an open, sunny spot in good drainage and is a great cut flower. Tumblers \$5 each

#### Graptophyllum ilicifolium – Holly Fuchia



H.2m W.2m A large, dense shrub with stiff, prickly foliage and bright red flowers in the leaf axis from winter to spring. Full sun to semi-shade in good drainage. Good for birds & native bees and can be pruned heavily. Tumblers \$5 each

#### Prostanthera ovalifolia – Rosea form



H.2m W.1m Upright shrub with soft, very aromatic foliage & masses of pinkish/mauve flowers late winter to spring. From full sun to heavy shade & very hardy once established. Tumblers \$5 each

#### **MELALEUCA FULGENS**

'Scarlet Honevmvrtle'



H. 1.5m W.1.5m Spreading shrub with delightful clusters of bright red, yellow-tipped flowers in spring. Very adaptable & okay in damp or semi-shade. Attracts honeyeaters.

WESTRINGIA FRUTICOSA 'Morning Light'



H.1.5m x W.1.5m

Dense plant with great variegated grey foliage making an outstanding contrast. White flowers are a bonus. Very hardy in full sun to semi-shade. Can be pruned heavily to shape.

ARCHIRHODOMYRTUS BECKLERI Rose Myrtle



H 3m x W 3m

A large shrub or small tree with glossy leaves and pink flowers followed by red, edible berries. Has very aromatic leaves when crushed. A rain-forest plant from the north coast & does well in full sun to semi-shade. Hardy once established and does well in a large pot.

#### **CLUMPING PLANTS**

#### Pattersonia occidentalis – native iris



Clumping plant to about soccer ball size with many stems of purple, three-petalled flowers around mid-spring Best in ample sun. Can be cut back to ground level to promote new growth.

#### CONOSTYLIS ACULEATA



H.20cm W.1.5m Clumping plant with strappy foliage and bright yellow/white flowers mid-winter to spring. Very hardy in reasonable drainage & best in ample sun. Flowers can be adversely affected by frost. Tumblers \$5 each

#### Libertia paniculata



A small, clumping plant about soccer-ball size with strappy foliage & sprays of lovely white flowers late winter & spring. Best in a shady spot & likes moisture. Tumblers \$5 each

DORYANTHUS EXCELSUS Gymea Lily



Clumping plant with broad, strappy leaves & 4m high flower spike with a massive red flower on top. Very hardy in most spots. 6"/140mm pots \$10 each
