**About the Last One:** It was a historic night on Wednesday for the Baysox, as Bowie slugged six home runs and tallied 20 hits en route to a 20-7 victory. The six home runs traveled a total of 2,413 feet. **Adley Rutschman** led the way offensively with his first professional multi-home run game. He hit one each from the left and right sides of the plate, and finished the game 3-5 with those two home runs, a double, and seven RBI. **Malquin Canelo** scored all five times he came up, including with a home run, and his five runs scored tied him for the Baysox record. **Toby Welk, Patrick Dorrian**, and **Chris Hudgins** also homered for Bowie. **Kyle Stowers** extended his hitting streak to 12 games with two hits on the night. In total, eight of the nine starters reached base at least three times, eight of nine had multi-hit games, six of nine scored multiple runs. On the mound, **Tim Naughton** earned the win in relief. Naughton is still yet to allow an earned run in July through six innings of work.

**Stowers' Power:** Promoted from the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds on June 22, outfielder **Kyle Stowers** has been on a tear in the month of July. This month, he is hitting .375 with five home runs, six doubles, 12 runs scored, 24 hits, and has an OPS of 1.177 in 18 games. He also has a hit in 12 straight games.

**Home against Hartford:** This is the second and final series against Hartford this season for the Baysox. In June, Bowie made the trip up to Connecticut and went 4-2 against the Yard Goats.

**Brnovich on the Bump:** Making his fourth start with the Baysox will be right-hander **Kyle Brnovich**. This is his first professional season and he began in High-A Aberdeen before being promoted to Bowie. He has thrown 17.0 innings for the Baysox, and has allowed six earned runs, and opponents are hitting .200 against him. His control is his strong point, as he has walked just two batters and struck out 17 in his time at the Double-A level. In his last start, facing Erie, Brnovich threw five scoreless innings and walked one with one hit and four strikeouts. For more information on Brnovich, see page two.

**In the Other Corner:** Starting for Hartford on Thursday will be the right-hander **David Hill**. He made six starts with High-A Spokane, and this will be his seventh start with Double-A Bowie. Opponents are hitting .324 against him, and he has walked seven batters as opposed to 24 strikeouts with Hartford.

**This Day in Baysox History:** Bowie has won seven straight games on July 22nd, with their last loss coming in 2014. In 2018 and 2019, Bowie swept doubleheaders on both days against Erie and Richmond, respectively.
