



BIOGRAPHY Mark Henn Animator

MARK HENN has been a leading figure within hand-drawn animation at Walt Disney Animation Studios since 1980 when he started as an in-betweener on "The Fox and the Hound." Less than a year later, he was given the plumb assignment of animating Mickey Mouse in "Mickey's Christmas Carol" (which marked the first big screen appearance for Mickey in thirty years). Henn has since gone on to become one of the most prolific and respected animators in the industry. Taking up the mantle once held by animation giant Marc Davis, he is known for supervising the animation of some of Disney's most beloved princesses/heroines including Ariel, Belle, Jasmine, Mulan, and Tiana.
