PHYTOSANITARY REQUIREMENTS PROPOSAL FOR THE IMPORT OF CARROT SEEDS (DAUCUS CAROTA) FOR PLANTING ORIGINATED IN AUSTRALIA

Article 1. Establish the mandatory phytosanitary requirements of compliance for the import of carrot seeds (*Daucus carota*) for planting originating in Australia.

Article 2. The phytosanitary import requirements are:

1. Plant Health Import Permit issued by the respective area of AGROCALIDAD.
2. Phytosanitary Export Certificate issued by the National Plant Protection Organization (NPPO) of Australia in which stated the following:

2.1. Additional Declaration: "The shipment is free of *Pseudomonas cichorii*, *Pseudomonas marginalis* pv. *marginalis*, *Pseudomonas viridiflava*, *Xanthomonas hortorum* pv. *carotae*, *Cirsium arvense*, *Cuscuta campestris*, *Cuscuta epithimum*, *Orobanche minor*, *Orobanche ramosa*, *Sonchus arvensis*, *Thlaspi arvense*, Arabis mosaic virus (ArMV), Carrot red leaf virus (CtRLV), Lettuce mosaic virus (LMV), Strawberry latent ringspot virus (SLRSV), Tobacco ringspot virus (TRSV) y *Anguina* sp. by certified laboratory No. "... " (Describe the number of laboratory diagnosis) ".

2.2. Pre shipment treatment: disinfection with Fludioxinol 2.5% + Metalaxyl-M 1% - FS, in a dose of 1 ml per liter of water or other products of similar action in dosages suitable for: *Albugo candida*, *Alternaria carotiincultae*, *Alternaria dauci*, *Alternaria longipes*, *Alternaria petroselini*, *Alternaria radicina*, *Cercospora carotae*, *Choanephora cucurbitarum*, *Cladosporium macrocarpum*, *Cladosporium sphaerospermum*, *Curvularia penniseti*, *Curvularia spicifera*, *Diplodia* sp., *Erysiphe heraclei*, *Itersonilia perplexans*, *Phoma complanata*, *Phoma eupyrena*, *Rhizoctonia crocorum*, *Septoria apiicola*, *Stemphylium* sp. y *Trichothecium roseum*.

3. Laboratory Certificate Annex.
4. The shipment must be free from soil and any foreign material.
5. The shipment will be contained in new packaging of first use and must be free from any foreign material.
6. Phytosanitary inspection at the point of entry.
