

## Wednesday Walk on Gossan Hill – 10 October 2012

The walk began from a walkway off Portus Place, Bruce. We immediately found many *Craspedia variabilis* in flower along with a good number of *Diuris nigromontana*, *Glossodia major* and a *Stegostyla cucullata* as well as several *Indigofera australis* covered in flowers. We then saw occasional flowers of *Pultenaea procumbens*, *Diuris pardina*, *Poranthera microphylla*, *Petalochilus fuscatus* before suddenly the smell of honey hit us and we were in a mass display of orange (*Dillwynia phylloides*), white (*Brachyloma daphnoides* - with the honey smell) and yellow (*Hibbertia riparia*). Interspersed were many more *P. fuscatus*, *G. major*, the 2 *Diuris* and *Grevillea alpina*. Everywhere we went there were mass displays - those already mentioned as well as *Stypandra glauca*, *Dillwynia sericea*, *Acacia buxifolia*, *Glycine clandestina*, *Daviesia mimosoides*, *D. ulicifolia* and many more. Other flowers of interest were *Chrysocephalum apiculatum* (the tall green form), *C. semipapposum*, a lovely patch of *Leucocrysum albicans* var. *tricolor*, *Thysanotus patersonii*, lots of *Luzula densiflora*, a few *Pterostylis nutans*, *Cyanicula caerulea*, *Acacia genistifolia*, *A. ulicifolia*, *Leucopogon virgatus* and even some grasses - *Dichelachne micrantha*, a *Austrodanthonia eriantha* and also a lovely *Poa* with blue-green leaves. We also found some interesting plants not yet flowering - *Astrotricha ledifolia*, *Billardiera scandens*, *Hibbertia calycina*, *Kunzea parvifolia*, *Leptospermum multicaule* (just a few flowers), *Erodium crinitum* and *Wahlenbergia stricta*, *W. communis*, *W. gracilis* and *W. multicaulis*.
