

Wednesday Walk along the Railway Line Near Williamsdale – 2 November 2011

After visiting several reserves in the Burra area, we finished the day with a short walk along part of the old railway line to the north of Williamsdale. There was an interesting array of plants with many in flower. Those we saw flowering included the endangered *Swainsona recta*, *Linum marginale*, *Velleia paradoxa*, *Lotus australis*, *Brachyloma daphnoides*, *Pultenaea procumbens*, *Dianella revoluta* and *Convolvulus erubescens*. There was also a pea we didn't recognise which had finished flowering – a *Dillwynia* of some sort.
