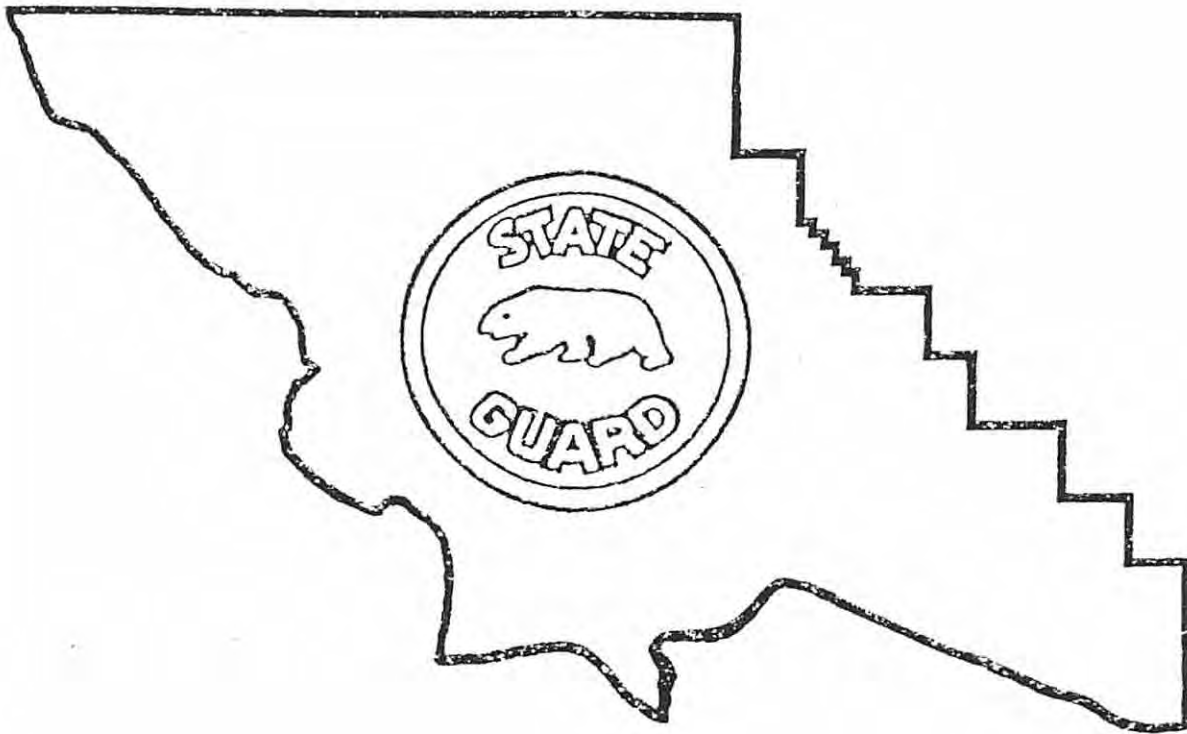

**W**elcome to the Atascadero Historical Society Museum. You are in one of California's truly remarkable historical buildings. Built in the years 1914 to 1918, it was to be the center-piece of a planned community developed by Edward Gardner Lewis, founder of Atascadero.

E. G. Lewis was a talented and creative businessman and publisher, who could write as eloquently as he spoke. In the early 1900's he developed University City near St. Louis, Missouri, and began building his large publishing enterprise.

In 1913 Lewis purchased the Atascadero Rancho, a 23,000 acre cattle ranch, from J. H. Henry. Located on California's historic El Camino Real, Atascadero is set in the rolling foothills of the Santa Lucia Mountains just west of the Salinas River. It was here that E. G. Lewis set about designing a completely self sufficient community, and laid out one of California's first planned cities. The services of many specialists in agriculture, geology, city planning and other fields, were obtained by Lewis to help develop Atascadero Colony, with an anticipated population of 30,000.

This building was the Atascadero Colony Administration Building. Constructed with bricks made from local clay and reinforced concrete, and built in the Italian Renaissance style, after Palladio, it is similar to Monticello the home of Thomas Jefferson. Bliss and Faville of San Francisco were the architects, and the F. O. Engstrom Company of Los Angeles was the builder. It was from here that Lewis orchestrated the development of the Colony.

This lovely rotunda, now serving as our museum, was designed to serve as an exhibit hall for agricultural and mineral products, as well as cultural and artistic displays. The surrounding smaller rooms, and those on the second and third floors were offices of the Colony Holding Company and its subsidiaries. The fourth floor is a single large room with domed ceiling that was to be the community library.

The Colony had a remarkable beginning, but after World War One the community fell on hard times; and in 1924 Lewis was forced into involuntary bankruptcy by a few of his creditors. The community did not experience much growth during the next thirty years. The population was never more than 5000 until the State of California located its State Hospital at the southern edge of Atascadero in 1954. Since that time the population has increased by about 5000 each decade. 🐾

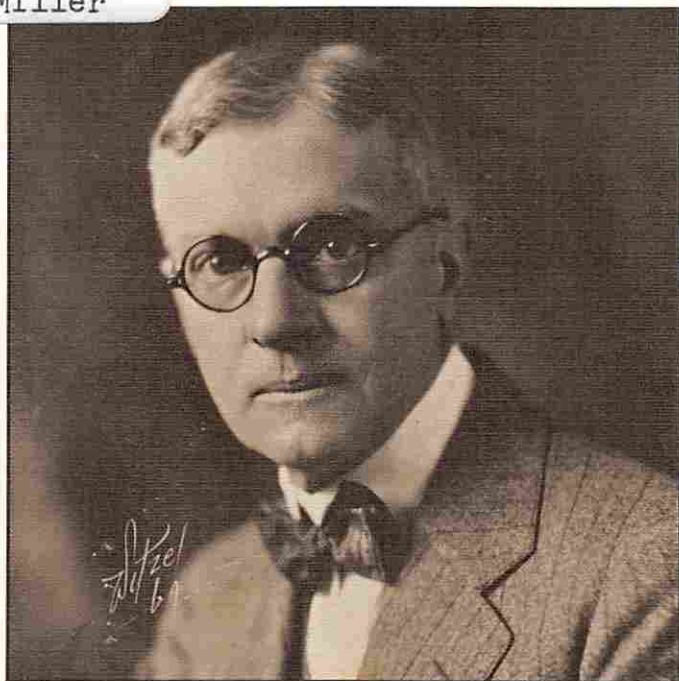
