Desmodium oojeinensis (Roxb.)H.Ohashi

Family: Paplionaceae Common name: Sandan Part used: Bark, roots

Description:

Desmodium oojeinensis is a small deciduous tree. Bark is deeply cracked and grey or dark brown in colour. Leaves are alternate and trifoliate type with petioles approximately 3.8-5 cm long. The leaves are lanceolate in shape with broadly ovate leaflets. The flowers are white or pink in colour. Pods are linear-oblong in shape and are light brown in colour. Pods contain about 2-5 seeds.

Utilization:

Bark fibers is used for making rope. Wood is used for making agricultural implements.
