## Clematis lasiantha Pipestem Clematis, Chaparral Clematis

VINE - deciduous (October through March).

Climbs to 15'.

Leaves have from 3 to 5 leaflets — attractive.

Flowers creamy with 50 to 100 stamens — January to June.

- The fruit is showy with long feathery styles.
- Native habitat: chaparral, open woodland below 6000' — North Coastal Range and Sierra Mountains to Baja California.
