PLANT DESCRIPTION

Plant Type:	Perennial
Height / Width:	1.5 ft. H x 1.5 ft. W
Plant Form:	Rounded, dense
Flower / Fruit:	Inconspicuous in late summer
Leaf Color, Size:	Small, linear, glossy copper-bronze leaves with serrated edges, on wine colored stems
Native To:	New Zealand

GROWING REQUIREMENTS

Zones:	Hardy to zero degrees
Soil:	Fast draining, poor, sandy
Water:	Average to wet
Sun:	Sun to part shade in hottest climate:
Care and Pruning:	Remove small flowers in late summer to prevent re-seeding
