APPENDIX F PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT

This appendix includes all information related to the public involvement process that was undertaken for this Master Plan Update. This Master Plan Update was conducted concurrently with the 14 CFR Part 150 Noise Compatibility Study Update for the Lambert-St. Louis International Airport (Lambert Airport). The public outreach undertaken during the Master Plan included elements of the Part 150 Study, which followed and adhered to 14 CFR Part 150 guidance. In addition to the master planning elements the public outreach effort allowed opportunities for public review and comment during the development of the Noise Exposure Maps (NEMs) and the Noise Compatibility Program (NCP). For this Master Plan Study, this process included the following efforts, which are described in detail in the following sections of this Appendix:

Each of these efforts facilitated the active and direct participation of local officials, airline and airport tenant representatives, and members of the public and provided the opportunity for them to submit comments during the course of the Master Plan Update Study.

F.1 COMMUNITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

A Community Advisory Committee (CAC) for the Lambert Airport 14 CFR Part 150 Noise Compatibility Study Update and the Master Plan Update Study was formed to serve as a sounding board and link to an array of stakeholders and interest groups within the aviation industry, the communities in the general airport vicinity, and key interest groups. The CAC was composed of representatives from federal, state, regional, and local agencies.

Throughout the conduct of the study, the CAC was advised of key technical data, and evaluation, and the overall study progress. The CAC provided comments to the FAA, client, and the consultant on the study data collection, analysis of alternative concepts, and the recommendations of the Master Plan Update.

CAC meetings were conducted on April 21, 2009; August 31, 2009; March 24, 2010; and September 9, 2010. The CAC meetings were held in the JoAnne Wayne Conference Room at Terminal 1 at Lambert Airport. The information provided to the CAC was also made available to the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and the general public on the project website and at Public Information Workshops (see Section F.2 Technical Advisory Committee and Section F.3 Public Information Workshops).

CAC MEETINGS

Four CAC meetings were conducted throughout the Master Plan Update to inform and seek input from the CAC members on the study processes and findings of both the Airport Master Plan Update and the Part 150 Study Update. The consultant and airport staff participated in formal presentations to the CAC. The meetings provided opportunities for the members to participate in 'working sessions' to brainstorm potential solutions to the study issues. The following paragraphs summarize the presentations and discussions at each CAC meeting that were related to the Master Plan Update.

Prior to each meeting, invitations letters were sent to the CAC members. Copies of the invitation letters are included later in this section.

CAC Meeting #1 - April 21, 2009 JoAnne Wayne Conference Room, Lambert-St. Louis International Airport 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

The first meeting of the CAC provided an overview of the Airport Master planning process, methodology, and the purpose. The presentation and discussion about Master Plan issues included the history, background, and recent trend in the aviation industry, both locally and nationally, that led up to this Master Plan Update. The presentation included a review of the forecast of aviation activity that was prepared to determine future facility requirements at Lambert Airport. This CAC meeting also included a discussion of potential collateral development areas and potential redevelopment options and strategies for these areas.

The presentation was followed by a "visioning session" in which CAC members were asked to provide input into the development of goals and objectives for the Lambert Airport and the role of the Airport in relation to the vision for the St. Louis Region.

Meeting attendance included 13 members of the CAC, staff from the FAA Airports Division, Lambert Airport staff, and consultant team. Meeting materials were distributed to members at the meeting and posted on the project website following the meeting. A copy of all meeting materials is provided later in this section.

CAC Meeting #2 - August 31, 2009 JoAnne Wayne Conference Room, Lambert-St. Louis International Airport 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

This meeting included a review of the study methodology, aviation activity forecast, and the visioning session from the April 21, 2009 CAC meeting. Also discussed were the airfield capacity analysis; and the assessment of the existing terminal area, including existing terminal capacity, constraints, and opportunities for redevelopment.

Meeting attendance included 11 members of the CAC, staff from the FAA Airports Division, Lambert Airport staff, and consultant team. Meeting materials were distributed to members at the meeting and posted on the project website following the meeting. A copy of all meeting materials is provided later in this section.

CAC Meeting #3 – March, 24, 2010 JoAnne Wayne Conference Room, Lambert-St. Louis International Airport 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

The third CAC meeting included an overview of the forecast sensitivity analysis; general facility requirements, including airline and airport maintenance facilities, airport rescue and fire fighting (ARFF) facilities, cargo facilities, fixed base operator (FBO) facilities; and terminal gate/space requirements and potential scenarios.

Meeting attendance included five members of the CAC, staff from the FAA Airports Division, Lambert Airport staff, and consultant team. Meeting materials were distributed to members at the meeting and posted on the project website following the meeting. A copy of all meeting materials is provided later in this appendix.

CAC Meeting #4 – September 9, 2010 JoAnne Wayne Conference Room, Lambert-St. Louis International Airport 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

The fourth CAC meeting included a discussion of the terminal space requirements, short-listed terminal development alternatives, airfield concepts and passenger parking concepts. Meeting attendance included seven members of the CAC, staff from the FAA Airports Division, Lambert Airport staff, and consultant team.





F.2 TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

A Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) was established to provide guidance to the St. Louis Airport Authority (STLAA), the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), and the Study Team regarding the Lambert-St. Louis International (Lambert Airport) Airport Master Plan Update and Part 150 Noise Compatibility Study Update. Meetings of the TAC occurred concurrently with the Community Advisory Committee (CAC). The membership of the TAC included representatives of Airport management, the FAA's Air Traffic Control organization, FAA Airports division, airport users, and land use management/planning staff from the jurisdictions surrounding Lambert Airport.

Throughout the study, the TAC was advised of key technical data, noise and land use alternatives being considered, and the overall study progress. The TAC advised the STLAA, the FAA, and the Study Team on the Airport Master Plan Update and Part 150 Noise Compatibility Study through a series of meetings. The TAC meetings provided a forum for members to comment and question the analyses and findings of the two studies.

The TAC meetings were conducted on August 31, 2009, April 25, 2009; March 24, 2010; and September 9, 2010. TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETINGS

Four TAC meetings were conducted throughout the study to inform and seek advice from the members on the process and findings of the concurrent Airport Master Plan Update and Part 150 Noise Compatibility Study Update. 



F.3 PUBLIC INFORMATION WORKSHOPS

The workshop environment provided the public with an opportunity to participate in one-on-one discussions with Lambert Airport staff, the FAA planning and environmental staff, and the consultant team and to review the information and analyses from the Master Plan Update and Part 150 Study Update and provide comments on study findings. Three Public Information Workshops were over the course of the Master Plan Update.

The first two workshops were repeated on two back-to-back nights in two different locations. The third workshop was held on one night only due to low attendance at the previous two workshops. In addition to the Public Information Workshops two committees were formed to provide input into the Study, a Community Advisory Committee (CAC) and a Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) (see Section F.1 Community Advisory Committee and Section F.2 Technical Advisory Committee for information about the presentations and materials discussed in these committees).

The Public Information Workshops used an open house format. This format allowed the public to view each of the study displays and discuss the data collection, analyses, and findings directly with team members. Board-mounted graphics displayed the current issues and analyses completed to date for both the Master Plan Update and Part 150 Update studies.

Prior to each workshop, press releases were sent to local newspapers and advertisements were published in local newspapers which provided information regarding the time, date and place of each workshop, and described the purpose of the workshop, and provided contact information for the project. In addition, the dates and times upcoming workshop were also published on the project website. Copies of the published notices, registration forms, handouts, and presentation materials from each of these workshops are included at the end of this section.

The presentation included an introduction and an overview of the study process, community involvement, purpose and goals of the Master Plan and Part 150 Study, a status report regarding the progress and findings for each study, and a description of next steps. At the end of the presentation there was a question and answer period.

The exhibit area for the Master Plan Update contained board-mounted graphics which displayed the history and background of planning and development at Lambert Airport, the forecast of aviation activity, the methodology that would be used to analyze facility demand and capacity, and the approach to identifying potential collateral development opportunities. In addition to the presentation boards, a brochure-style handout was provided for the attendees to learn more about the Master Plan and Part 150 processes in greater detail.

Fifteen people attended this first pair of workshops. Five written comments were received during the Public Information Workshop from residents in the area with concerns about airport noise and/or requests to allow the placement of temporary noise monitoring equipment on their property.


