

Dodonaea pinnata (Pinnate Hop Bush)

Description

A spreading shrub, with an unusual but interesting form.

Flower and Foliage

Dense cloak of straight hairs on fern like leaves with a nice soft texture. Large and glossy red or green fruit.

Maintenance

Tip prune soft green growth in early stages of growth.

Occurs

Likes rocky ground and soils. Confined to the Sydney & Hawkesbury district.

Uses

A small shrub for the garden, ideal for garden in fills and smaller gardens or courtyards. An interesting plant with its appearance. Attracts native fauna.
