Topic: Dendrobiums of Papua New

Guinea

Dendrobium is a huge genus. There are more than a thousand species native to tropical Asia, New Guinea, Australia, and the Pacific islands. So many Dendrobium species are native to New Guinea that it's

thought that this is where the genus originated and then spread from there.

This month, Carol Klonowski from California will show us the wealth of Dendrobium species from Papua New Guinea. Carol has been growing orchids since the 1980s when a friend in Berkeley,



California gave her a Cattleya orchid and it bloomed with big lavender flowers and an intoxicating fragrance. She built a greenhouse in her backyard, and the rest is history.

Carol has been president of the Orchid Society of California and is an AOS judge with the California Sierra Nevada Judging Center.

In New Guinea, Dendrobiums are incredibly varied. They grow everywhere from the hot lowland jungles to the cool mountain cloud forests. Want to see these amazing orchids? Don't miss this meeting!
