Plant Diseases Act 1914

Plant Diseases Amendment Regulations 2010

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Plant Diseases Amendment Regulations 2010*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Plant Diseases Regulations 1989*.

4. Regulation 6A inserted

After regulation 5 insert:

6A. Entry and keeping of diseases

A person must not —

- (a) bring into the State; or
- (b) possess within the State,

a disease listed in Schedule 11 unless the Director General has approved of the person doing so and the person complies with any conditions imposed by the Director General.

Penalty: a fine of \$5 000.

Misuse of Drugs Amendment Regulations 2010

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Misuse of Drugs Amendment Regulations 2010*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;

3. Regulations amended

- (ii) a justice of the peace or a registrar of the Magistrates Court, other than a registrar of the Magistrates Court who is a police officer;

- (iv) an approved analyst or an approved botanist.
