

## **River Paperbark**

Melaleuca trichostachya mel-luh-LOO-kuh trik-oh-STA-kee-uh Category: Tree (5-10m) Height: 5-10 metres Spread: 2-5 metres







## Interestingly-scented foliage and lovely white/cream flowers that attract insects and are a great source of pollen for bees.

This paperbark doesn't mind moist areas and is adaptable to a range of soil types. Great to use as a screening tree. It is normally found alongside riverbeds and water courses where it can be exposed to extreme conditions like drought and flooding.



Drought tolerant once established



Adaptable to most soil conditions
