Interestingly-scented foliage and lovely white/cream flowers that attract insects and are a great source of pollen for bees.

This paperbark doesn't mind moist areas and is adaptable to a range of soil types. Great to use as a screening tree. It is normally found alongside riverbeds and water courses where it can be exposed to extreme conditions like drought and flooding.

HOT TIP: Prune when young to create a dense shrub or hedge.
