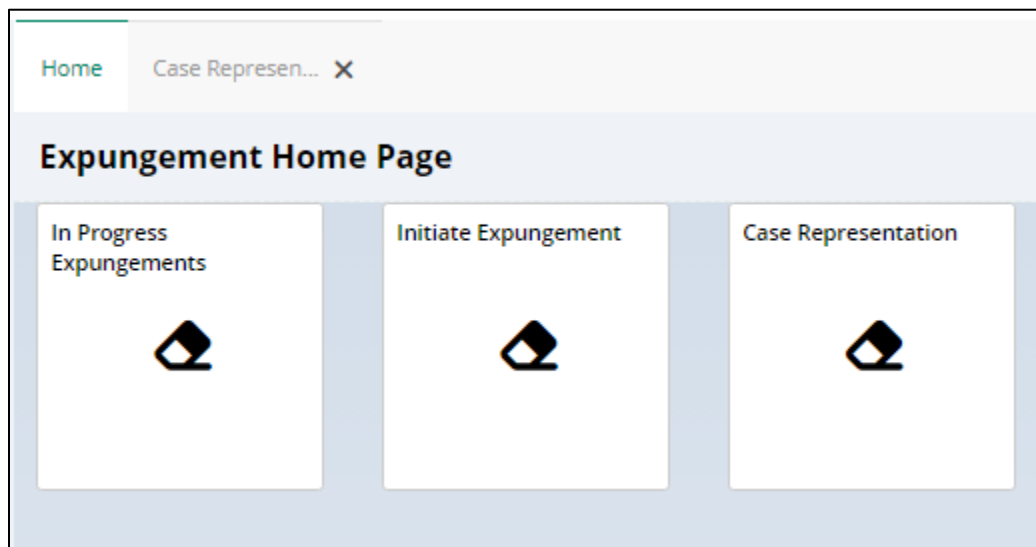



County and Central Public Defender Notification Emails

County and Central Public Defenders will receive an email when they file an expungement, when a petition is returned, and various events about the case. Notification emails will be stored in the Case Jacket to review. The following are the events that trigger an email notification:

- Expungement Petition Filed or Revised
- Amended Expungement Petition is Filed or Revised
- Prosecutor submits a response to the Petition or an Amended Proposed Order
- Prosecutor returns the Petition to the Petitioner or an Amended Proposed Order
- Court Staff/Judge provides a Judicial Decision
- Court Staff/Judge provides a Granted Judicial Decision for Amended Order
- A Petition is Withdrawn
- Court Staff modifies the case status from "Pending Prosecutor review" to "Pending Petitioner Response"
- Court Staff modifies the case status from "Revised Petition Prosecutor Review" to "Pending Petitioner Response"
- Hearing Date Scheduled

Self-Represented Litigant's (Pro Se) Process Flow Updates


Self-represented litigants will now retain their submitted expungement petitions once returned by the Prosecutor, unless they consent to allow the County Public Defender to represent them on the expungement case. If a prosecutor returns the petition, the self-represented litigant will see the 'Open' button enabled and be able to work on the petition.

On the Verification screen, a self-represented litigant will be able to select an option consenting to allow County Public Defender to handle the expungement petition if the petition is returned by the Prosecutor. By selecting the checkbox, the County Public Defender can assign themselves to the case if the petition is returned.

Figure 14. New Workbasket Fields

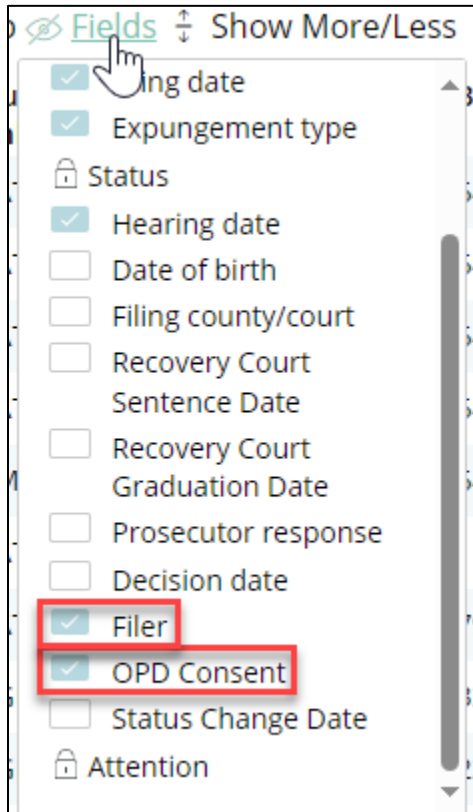
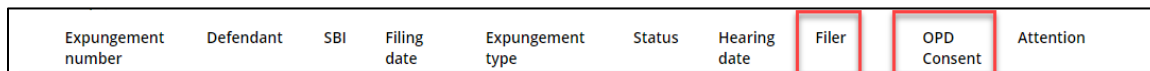
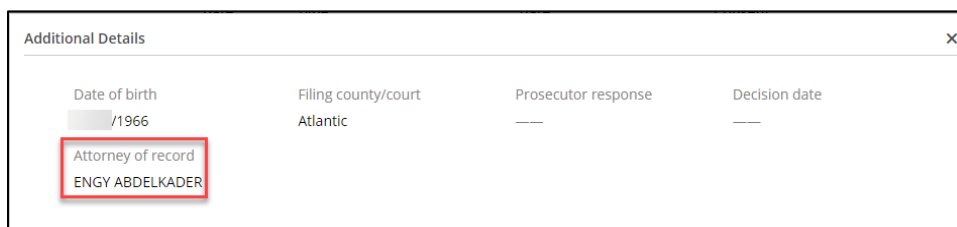


Figure 15. Fields added to the Columns of the Workbasket

CAPS Fees and Fines Data Displayed Within the Financial Data Section

The Expungement System has been updated such that probation fees and fines will be retrieved from the Comprehensive Automated Probation System (CAPS). The cases selected for expungement will be matched against the petitioner's information in CAPS and pulled into the Expungement System on the Proposed Order screen. Any unmatched CAPS information is displayed, and you'll still be able to add any additional CAPS/fees and fines information.

On the Proposed Order screen, there is a "Refresh" button that will retrieve any new CAPS data. The data should be reviewed for accuracy. The screen shot below shows that matched CAPS data was found associated with a selected case to be expunged.

Petitioners Can Change the Expungement Type for Clean Slate and Regular Expungement Types

For a Regular or Clean Slate expungement that is returned by the Prosecutor and in the status 'Pending Petitioner Response', petitioners will be able to change the expungement type from regular to clean slate, or clean slate to regular.

If the order is changed from Clean Slate to regular, cases on the case list will be deselected by default.

If the order is changed from Regular to Clean slate, cases on the case list will be selected by default.

If an expungement type is changed from Clean Slate to Regular and vice versa, the Proposed Order PDF will reflect the appropriate expungement type.



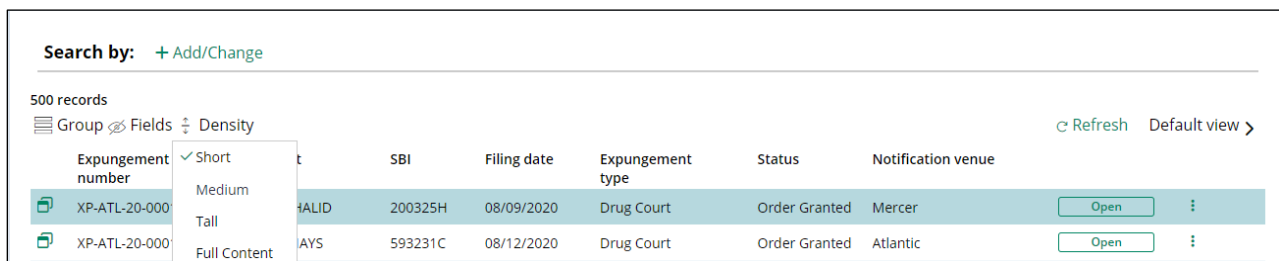

Figure 2 – Adding Fields to the Grid



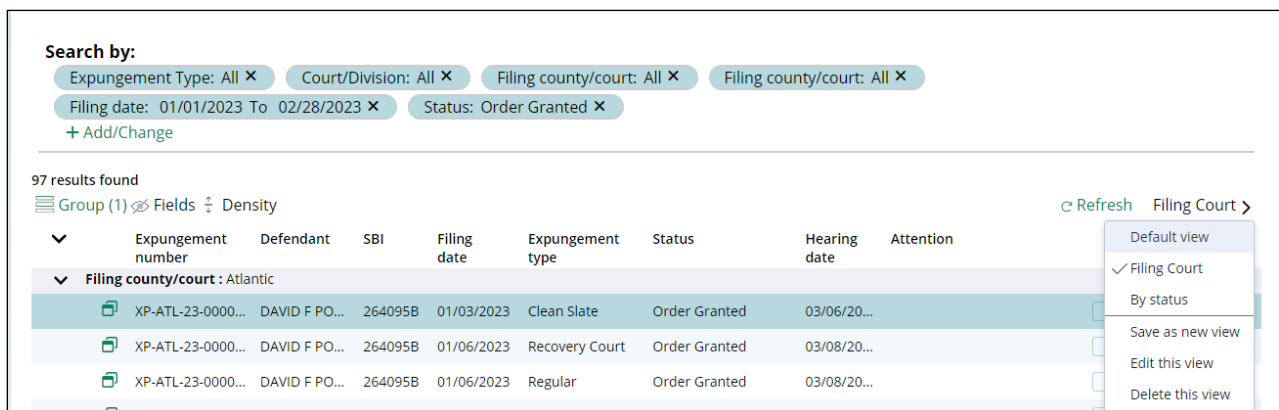





Expungement Petition Status Change

Court Staff and Judges can now modify the **Case Status** when the Status is “Pending Prosecutor Review”, “Revised Petition Prosecutor Review”, “Pending Petitioner Response”, and “Awaiting Judicial Decision”.

Statuses can be updated as follows:

- From Pending Prosecutor Review, the status can be updated to Pending Petitioner Response or Awaiting Judicial Decision.
- From Revised Petition Prosecutor Review, the status can be updated to Pending Petitioner Review or Awaiting Judicial Decision.
- From Pending Petitioner Response, the status can be updated to Revised Petition Prosecutor Review or Awaiting Judicial Decision.
- From Awaiting Judicial Decision the status can be updated to Revised Petition Prosecutor Review, Pending Prosecutor Review or Pending Petitioner Response.

When Court staff changes the status, a case jacket entry will be added denoting the change. When the status is changed to Pending Petitioner Response, an email notification will be sent to the petitioner (private attorney or to the County Public Defender general mailbox if it was initiated by a self-represented litigant).

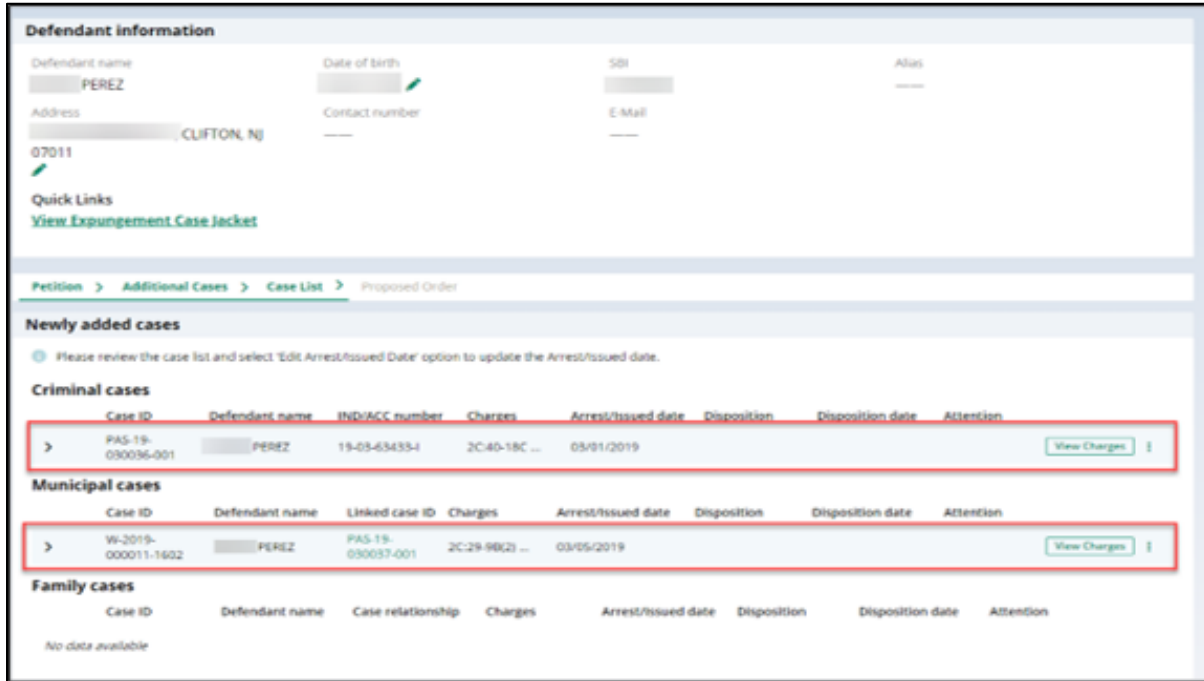

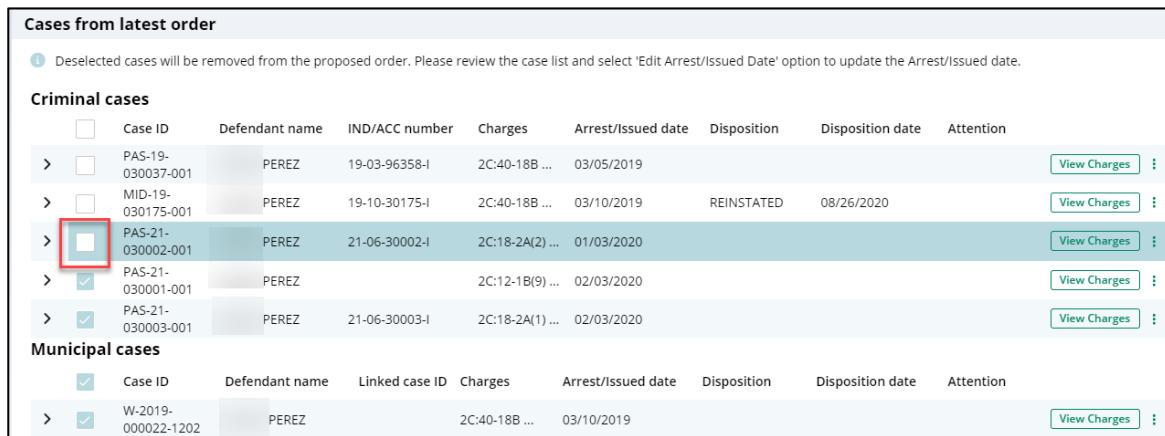

Unchecked cases will be removed from the proposed amended expungement order but can be added back if the proposed amended order is returned to you (the petitioner). The expungement types this applies to are **Regular**, **Clean Slate**, and **Recovery Court. Marijuana** and **Marijuana Decriminalization** expungements follow the original flow and are submitted to the Court without Prosecutor review.

The **Proposed Order** screen displays a new field for the **Amendment Reason**. The Amendment Reason text must be added and will be displayed on the Proposed Amended Order PDF. Notified agencies from prior order as well as parties/agencies from the newly added cases will be displayed under listed Notified agencies, but additional Notified agencies can be added manually by using “Other applicable party(ies)” option. Financial obligations/Restitution Details can also be added as applicable.

After submission, the status will change to **Amended Order Prosecutor Review**, or **Amended Order Judicial Decision (for Marijuana and Marijuana Decriminalization expungement types only)**. When you save an Amend Order without submitting, the status changes to **Draft Amended Order**. If an Amend Order is returned by the Prosecutor, the status will change to **Amended Order Petitioner Response**. Once an Amend Order is granted the status will update to **Amended Order Granted**.

An additional status of Amended Order Prosecutor Review is added to the County Prosecutor’s workbasket. The process is the same as the normal expungement petition filing process. County Prosecutors will see the Case List screen and Response screen. Prosecutors can object to the Amended Order and add comments on charges. The Response narrative field becomes mandatory if an objection is entered and/or if the petition is being returned to the petitioner.



The Prosecutor Response tab has been updated where the Prosecutor is presented with two questions that allows them to send the case back to the petitioner for revision or send along to the Court with their response letter.

The following questions are presented:

- Do you have an objection to the expungement petition?
- Do you want to return to the petitioner for any amendments/corrections to the petition?

The questions provide the Prosecutor with several options on how to proceed.

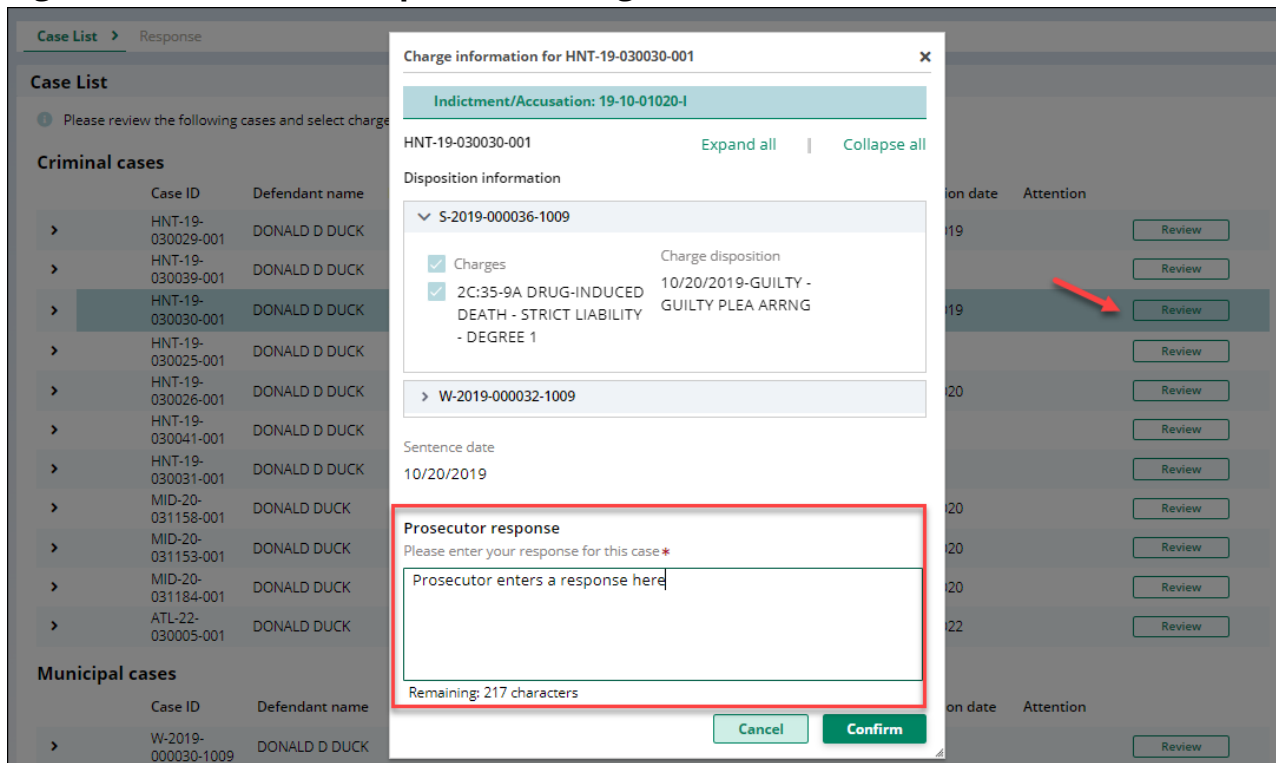
Figure 4 – Prosecutor has no objection and submits to the Court

A Prosecutor Response Letter is generated, added to the case jacket and email notifications are sent to the petitioner whenever the Prosecutor returns an expungement case to the petitioner, objects to the petition or both.

The Prosecutor Response Letter will generate with all case/charge selections that were entered on the View Charges screen. When the petitioner has made proper revisions, be sure to **deselect** the charge that was initially marked for review.





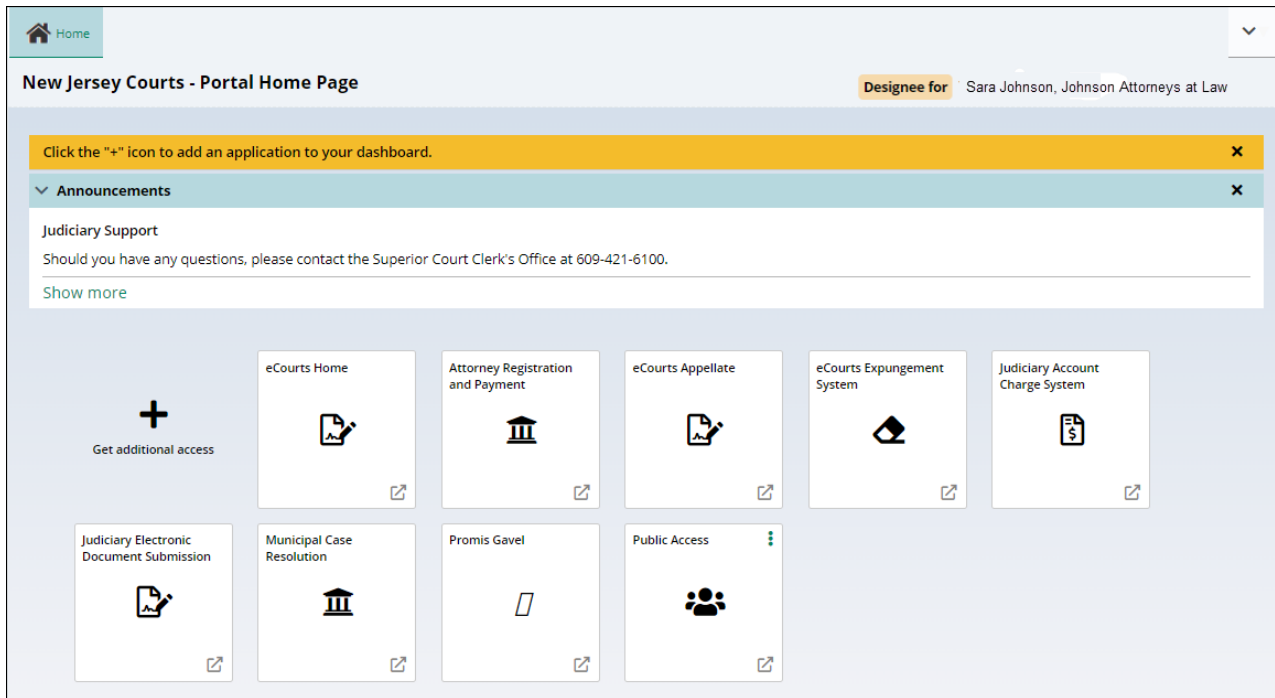
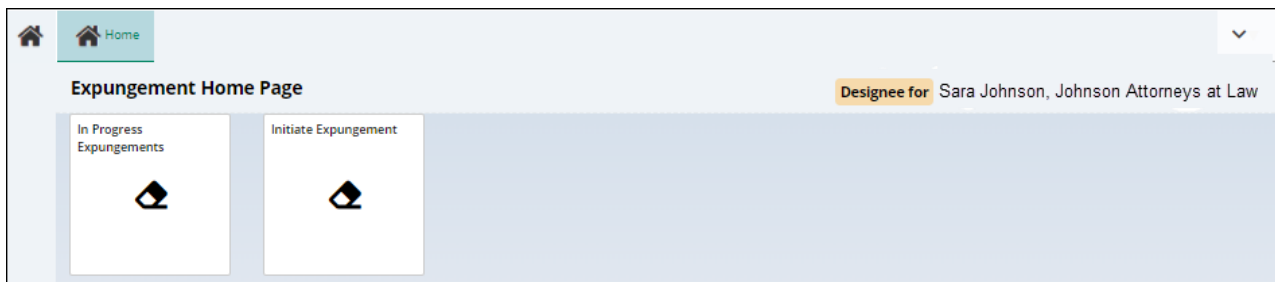


Figure 5 – Expungement Home Page as designee



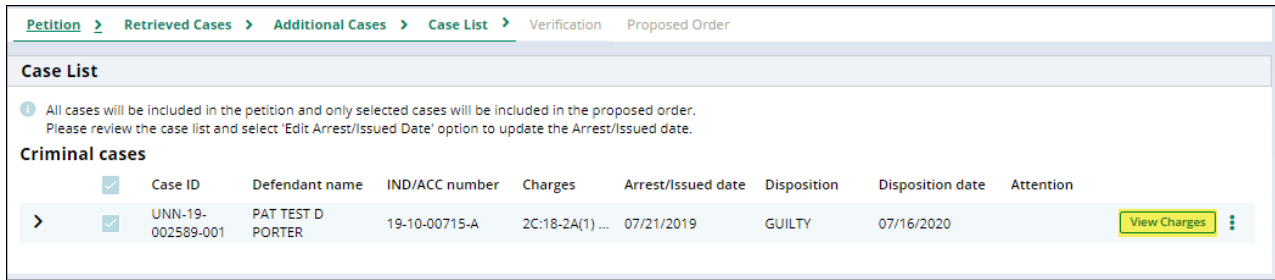
Figure 1 – View Charges button on the Retrieved cases screen

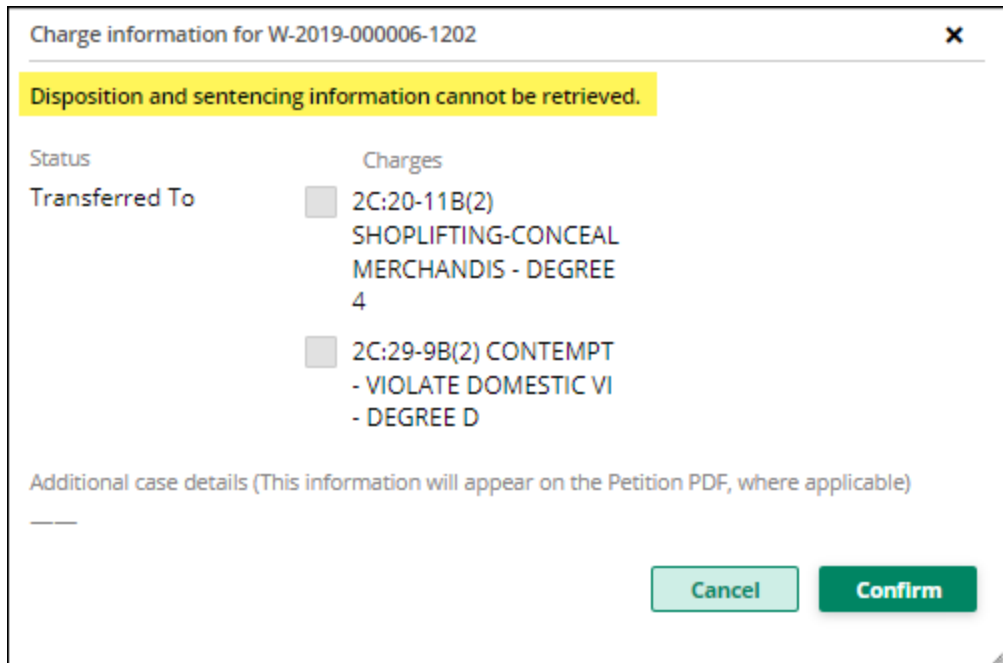

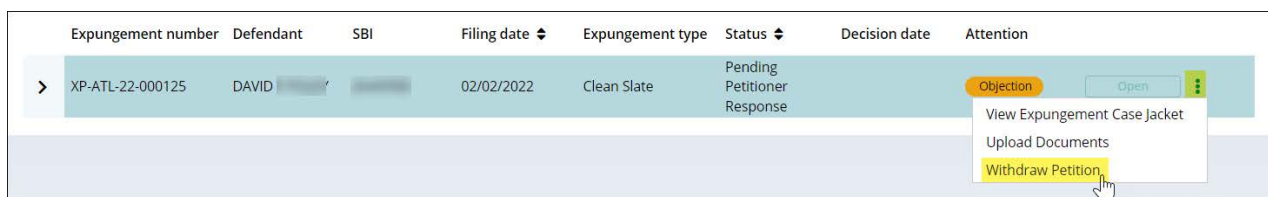

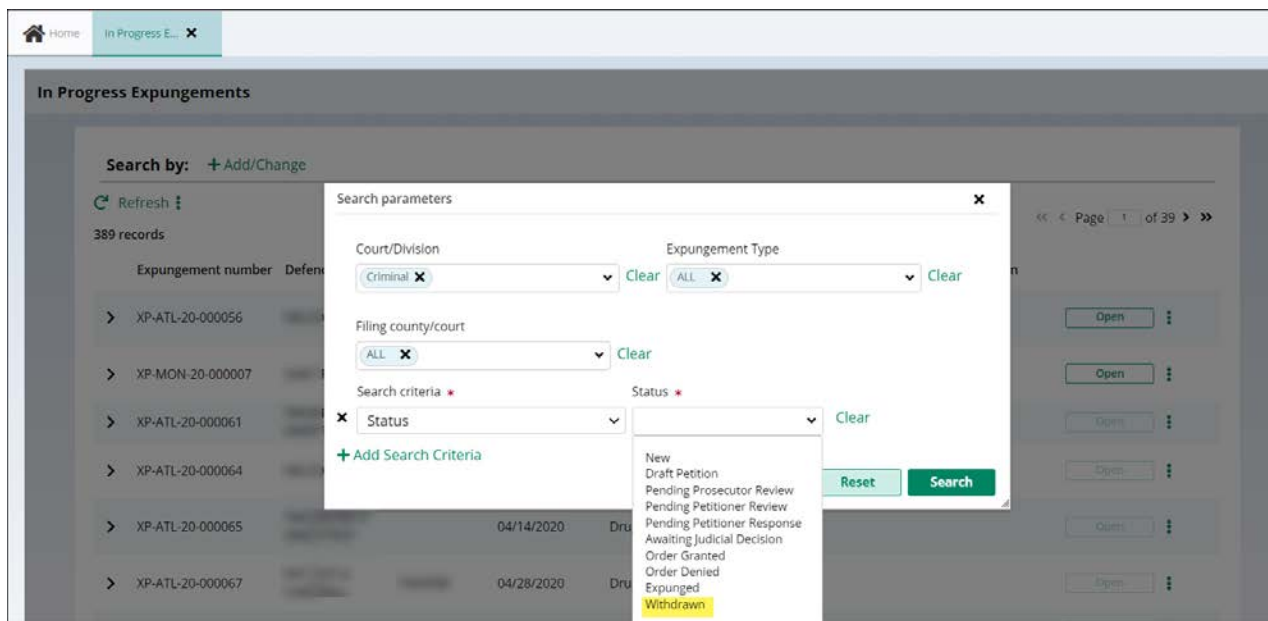





Central Office and County Public Defender Filing of Additional Expungement Types

Central and County Public Defenders can now initiate **Clean Slate, Regular, Marijuana, Marijuana Decriminalization,** and **Drug Court** expungement petitions by searching a Criminal, Municipal, or Family case. In addition, they can also withdraw petitions for these expungement types.

When **Clean Slate and Regular expungement petitions** are submitted, the petition is sent to the Prosecutor's workbasket and the status is updated to 'Pending Prosecutor Review'.

When **Marijuana and Marijuana Decriminalization expungement petitions** are submitted, the petition is sent to the Court Staff/Judge's workbasket and status updates to 'Awaiting Judicial Decision'.

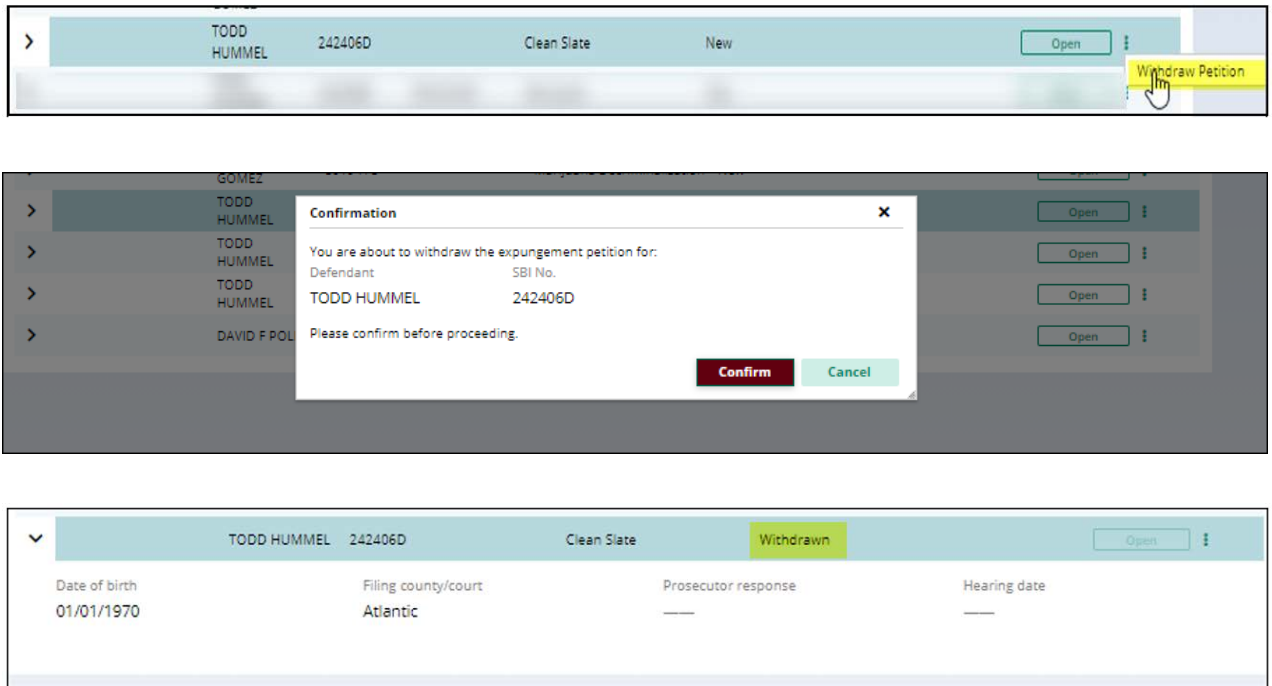



- Central Office and County Public Defenders can now search, filter, and view expungement petitions in the *In Progress Workbasket* for the following Expungement Types: **Clean Slate, Regular, Marijuana, Marijuana Decriminalization**, and **Drug Court**.
- Central Office and County Public Defender's *In Progress Workbasket* will display an Objection icon in the **Attention** column when there is a prosecutor objection response submitted on **Clean Slate** and **Regular** expungement petitions. These petitions will be updated to *Pending Petitioner Response* status.

Marijuana Decriminalization Expungement Type

A new expungement type, Marijuana Decriminalization, can now be initiated through the system.

Public Defenders, Private Attorneys and Self-Represented litigants can now initiate a **Marijuana Decriminalization** expungement by searching with a Criminal, Municipal, or Family case.

Note: The Financial Obligations/Restitution Details section on the Proposed Order screen is disabled for Marijuana Decriminalization expungements.

When the Proposed Order is submitted, the proposed order is sent to the Court Staff/Judge's workbasket and status updates to 'Awaiting Judicial Decision'. Email notifications will be sent to the filer/petitioner (self-represented litigant or private attorney).

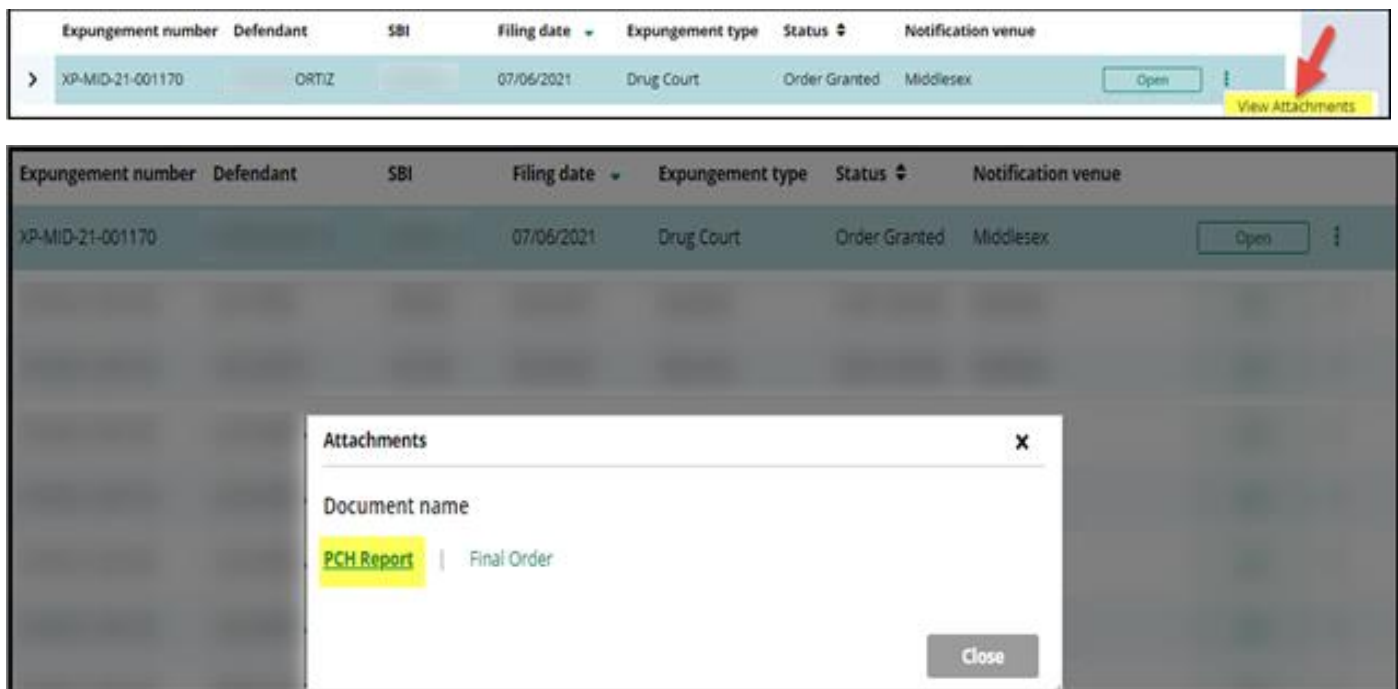


Figure 8 – PCH Report link under Related Links

Figure 1 – Notification Workbasket

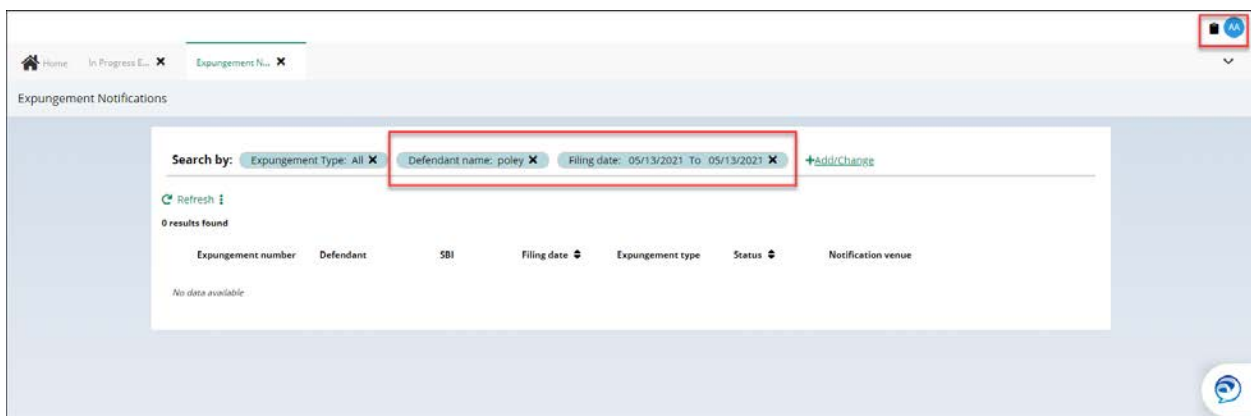
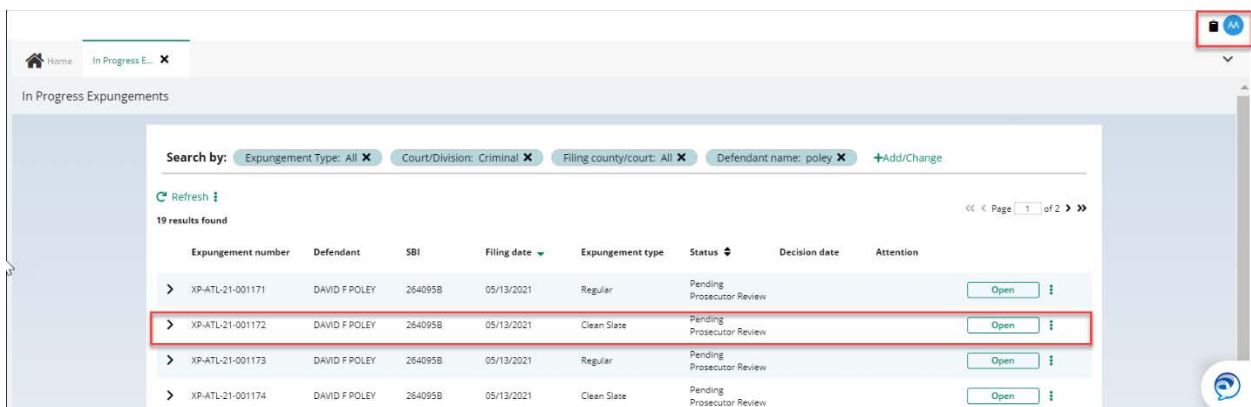


Figure 2 – In Progress Workbasket




Figure 1 – Workbasket Menu – View Notification Status

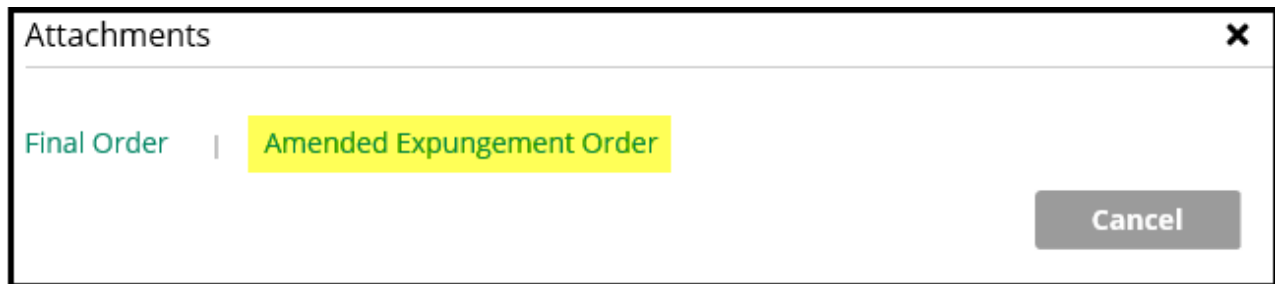





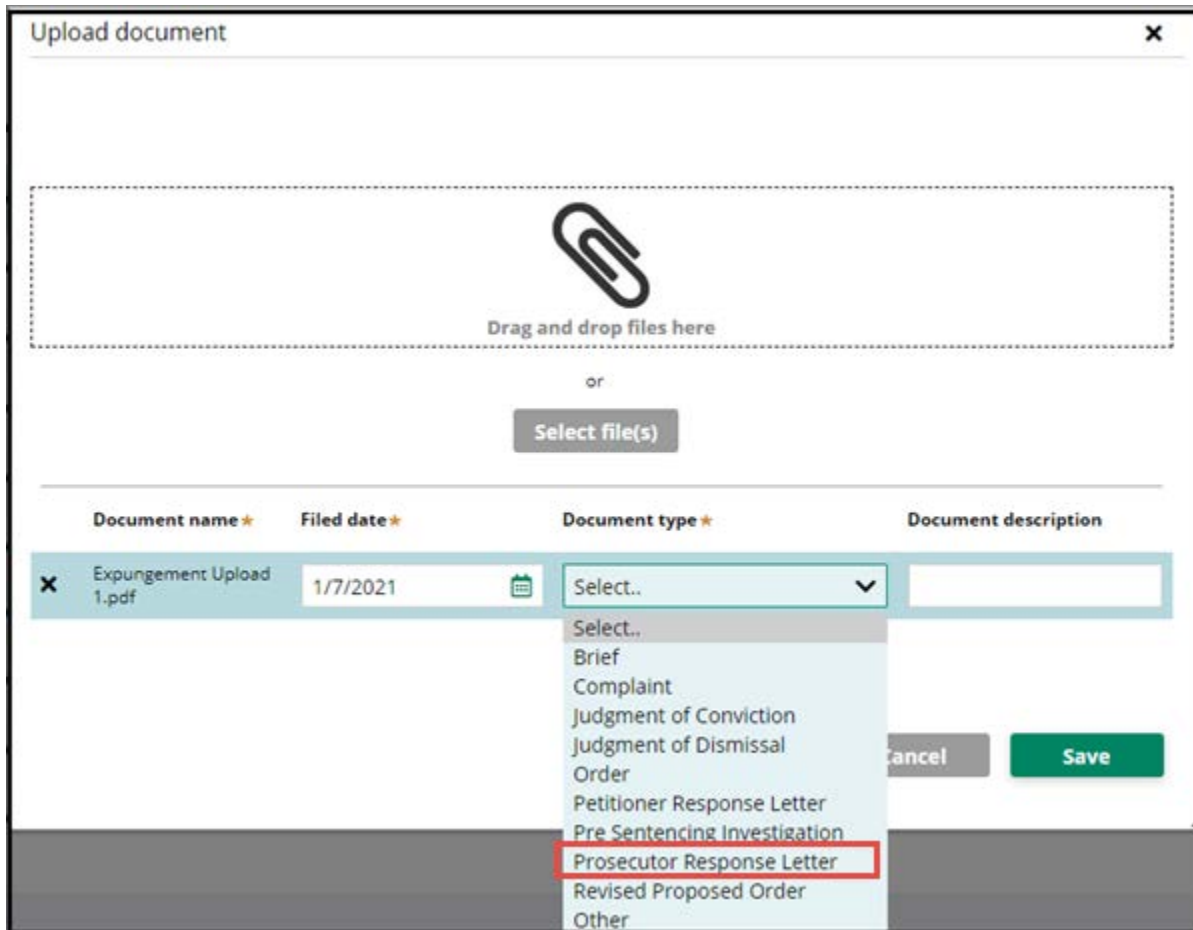

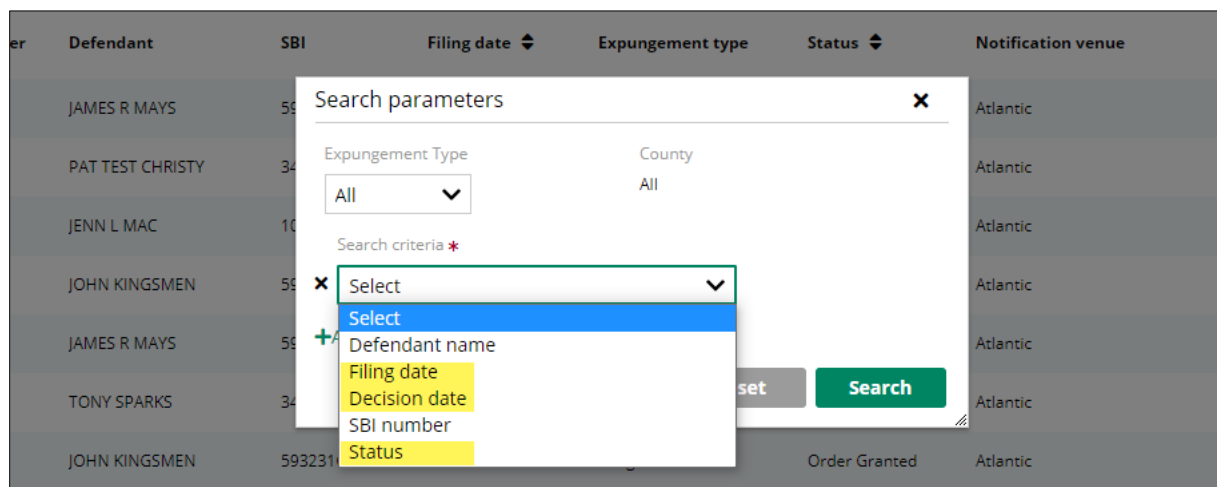

Figure 1 – Updated Search Criteria Values for Expungement Notifications Workbasket




