## This fast spreading, flat ground cover is the perfect plant for slopes.

- An amazingly flat, fast spreading ground cover that outcompetes weeds.
- Its red flowers are a nice addition.
- Stays very prostrate and spreads quickly once established.
- Use a native or slow release fertiliser sparingly.
- Down Under™ Grevillea needs reasonable drainage, or needs to be planted on slopes or raised gardens if soil drainage is not up to scratch.

Density	1–3 per m²
Height & Width	20-35cm x 3m
Flowering	Red flowers in winter/spring
Best Planting Time	March-November
Uses	Ground cover, mass planting, embankments, slopes
Position	Full sun to light shade; tolerates drought
Soil Type	Well drained soils, prefers slopes or raised gardens if heavy poor draining soils
Care	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; use a native or slow release fertiliser sparingly; prune edges as required, and prune the top back every 3 to 4 years
