*Grevillea laurifolia* 'TWD02' (b)

**This fast spreading, flat ground cover is the perfect plant for slopes.**

- An amazingly flat, fast spreading ground cover that outcompetes weeds.
- Its red flowers are a nice addition.
- Stays very prostrate and spreads quickly once established.
- Use a native or slow release fertiliser sparingly.
- Down Under™ Grevillea needs reasonable drainage, or needs to be planted on slopes or raised gardens if soil drainage is not up to scratch.



<b>Description</b>	Low, fast spreading ground cover
<b>Density</b>	1–3 per m <sup>2</sup>
<b>Height &amp; Width</b>	20–35cm x 3m
<b>Flowering</b>	Red flowers in winter/spring
<b>Best Planting Time</b>	March–November
<b>Uses</b>	Ground cover, mass planting, embankments, slopes
<b>Position</b>	Full sun to light shade; tolerates drought
<b>Soil Type</b>	Well drained soils, prefers slopes or raised gardens if heavy poor draining soils
<b>Care</b>	Water as required for 8–13 weeks until established; use a native or slow release fertiliser sparingly; prune edges as required, and prune the top back every 3 to 4 years
<b>Where It Works</b>	South QLD, NSW, VIC, ACT, TAS, SA & WA
