Christmas greetings,

Lux Venit! The Light has come! Over two thousand years ago near Bethlehem, an angel appeared to a group of men and women tending sheep in the small village of Beit Sahour, "House of Sheep". These were people who would have been looked down upon because of their task of raising the animals that would be used in the Temple sacrifices. Imagine their joy at the news that the One who would save them, **EMMANUEL**, "God With Us", had been born in the city of David. The sign that this was true was that they would find an infant wrapped in swaddling clothes lying in a manger. The shepherds, hoping for liberation from the oppression of their burdened life, went running to the manger. Before any kings or wise men would arrive and see the Savior, these people of the fields, ordinary people were the first to see the Christ, the Lamb of God, their hope.

"Joseph too went up from Galilee from the town of Nazareth to Judea, to the city of David that is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and family of David, to be enrolled with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child." Luke 2: 4-5 The name Bethlehem in Hebrew means "House of Bread." Jesus, the Bread of Life, was born in the city whose name refers to bread itself. As the Bread of Life, Jesus is nourishment for our spiritual and daily life. As the last sacrament we receive, **Viaticum**, or food for the journey. That journey is from this earthly life to eternal life. What better food to receive as one of our final meals or acts, Jesus in the Host, Communion, the Eucharist!

She wrapped him in swaddling clothes and laid him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn." Luke 2: 6-7 Have you ever wondered what a manger is? Perhaps you've heard. It is often thought to be a crib, because that is where Jesus was laid by his mother. Remember though the Jesus was born in a stable, a cave that was used to keep animals. A manger is really an open box or trough from which horses and cattle would eat. And so it was that he who would become for us the Bread of Life was placed in a receptacle that was actually for food, but he is food for us!

And suddenly there was a multitude of the heavenly host with the angel, praising God and saying: "Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests." Luke 2: 13-14

Glory to God in the Highest!
