# Pathways

Pathways offers a full spectrum of support and opportunities for former foster youth, ages 18 to 24, in Los Angeles County, including housing, educational mentoring and assistance, career/vocational counseling and development, life skills training, health education and mental health services, and ongoing alumni services, all aimed at increasing youth's self-sufficiency.

"Interning at Warner Bros was an amazing life-changing opportunity for me. I was able to break barriers, obtain special skills, grow individually, and learn about business entertainment. Before beginning the internship, I completed a 36-hour work readiness training with Pathways, which better prepared me for the job. I had the pleasure of working in the World Wide TV Marketing Department in Social Media Marketing. My duties included creating content for our on and off-air shows, giving ideas for marketing strategies via Facebook, Snapchat, and Twitter, and creating a look book for San Diego's annual ComicCon. Entering the internship, I was scared to network and ask

questions. However, I took the advice the HR department offered and threw myself out there. My confidence level in my networking skills grew, which allowed me to communicate more effectively. I had the best supervisors who made me feel comfortable to always ask questions, which made it easier for me to do my job. My advice to future Pathways applicants is to not be afraid. ## RESIDENTS AND ALUMNI IN OUR PATHWAYS PROGRAM

Residents and alumni received services and support through Pathways Housing and Alumni Programs

87% of youth in the program obtained employment

73% of youth exited to permanent or stable housing

hours of career and educational services were provided to Pathways residents and alumni

# Education

Our 11-year education support continuum follows foster youth from the seventh grade through the completion of a Bachelor's Degree. UFC's College Readiness and College Sponsorship Programs work harmoniously to create this pipeline for success.



Shari Walker, a Brass Ring youth speaker in 2013 and a highlight story in our 12-13 annual report, spoke at the Foster Youth Education Summit in Sacramento. In a room with 500 attendees, Shari was asked the question, "If I were to give you five million dollars to create your own program for foster youth what would you create?" Shari answered, "If I had five million dollars I would create a program like United Friends of the Children. At UFC there is no age cut off, they are in your life forever. While in college they would do things that other people wouldn't really think of. They would send us cookies every semester, care packages when we first

moved into our dorm room, and would help us set up

our first apartment. People forget that if you don't have family you're not getting care packages, you may not even get wished happy birthday, you might not get anything. UFC still sends me birthday cards and I'm 24 years old! A lot of foster youth don't have that support system. When you have a real organization like UFC who is like family and genuinely cares about you, and when you accomplish something and call them and they are just as excited as you, that hits your heart."

# Walgreens

Beginning the summer of 2015, **UFC's Pathways Career and** Education team has worked in conjunction with Walgreens on The Grocery Industry Initiative to prepare the transition aged youth in the Pathways Program for positions in the grocery industry. Many of these jobs, both part and full-time, come with benefits, scholarships and tuition reimbursement for post-secondary education, and career advancement. Walgreens partnership with our Pathways Program guided eight youth in completing our 3-week Work Readiness Training, obtaining the LA Chamber Work Readiness Certification (WRC) and attending the orientation conducted by iFoster.

Additionally, thanks to Walgreens, the College Sponsorship Program was able to send care packages to 40 college freshmen during their first round of final exams. Through the notebooks, cough drops, tissues, and other personal care items, our scholars received the message that someone believes in their ability to succeed. This would not have been possible without the generous support of our partner!



- 11<sup>th</sup> Annual College Readiness holiday party hosted for 300 scholars, family members, staff and volunteers.




# Evaluation

The overarching aim of evaluation is to assess the effectiveness of our programs in improving outcomes for both current and former foster youth as well as to study the impact of UFC's relationship-based approach to serving youth on program outcomes. From June 2015 through February 2016 we completed preliminary work with a consulting firm, ICF International, to assess evaluation readiness for an impact evaluation. Their work included database assessment, review of historical data, and appraisal of organizational readiness for evaluation and mapping of outcomes and indicators which resulted in the UFC Indicator framework. We also continued working towards finalizing logic models for each program by engaging all program staff. We contracted with Child Trends to summarize ICF International's evaluation work that included Executive Summary, Indicator refinement, and recommendations for the next phase.




