

TUFF-BRITE 97 is an excellent protective fungicide for control of a broad spectrum of fungal organisms, such as molds and decay fungi, which deface and rot lumber. **TUFF-BRITE 97** is effective when applied as a protective fungicide against the following surface fungi: *Trichoderma viride, Trichoderma harzianum, Penicillium expansum, Penicillium decumbens, Aspergillus flavus, Aspergillus niger, Auriobasidium pullulans, Ceratocystis pilifera Diplodia gossypina, and Gliocladium deliquescens.* **TUFF-BRITE 97** is effective when applied as a protective fungicide against the following wood decaying fungi: *Coniophora puteana* (syn. *Coniophora cerebella), Gloeophyllum trabeum* (syn. *Lenzites trabea), Irpex lactaus* (syn. *Polyporus tulipiferae), Lentinus lepideus, Merulius lacrymans* (syn. *Serpula lacrymans), Pleurotus ostreatus, Poria incrassata, Postia placenta* (syn. *Poria monticcia, Poria placenta*), *Trametes versicolor* (syn. *Coriolus versicolor, Polyporus versicolor*).
